PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of His Majesty EDWARD VIII. by the Grace of GOD of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India :

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir REGINALD EDWARD STUBBS, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Territories and Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by Article 17 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, it is provided that the State Council shall meet in session at such time, not being later than one month after the completion of every general election, as the Governor shall appoint by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette* :

And whereas a general election of members was completed on the 10th day of March, 1936 :

Now, therefore, know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, do hereby appoint 10 o'clock in the forenoon of the 17th day of March, 1936, as the time at which the State Council shall meet in session.

Given at Kandy, in the Island of Ceylon, this Eleventh day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-six.
