Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 1 of 1936.

No. 1 of 1889.

An Ordinance to amend the Courts Ordinance, 1889.

R. E. STUBBS.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :--

Short title and commencement.

Amendment of section 8 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1889.

Amendment of

section 54A of the principal Ordinance. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Courts Amendment Ordinance, No. 1 of 1936, and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall appoint by proclamation published in the Government Gazette.

2 Section 8 of the Courts Ordinance, 1889, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended as follows :---

- by the substitution for the words "six judges" of the words "seven judges";
- (2) by the substitution for the words "five Puisne Justices " of the words "six Puisne Justices"; and
- (3) in the marginal note thereto, by the substitution for the word "four", of the word "six".

3 Section 54A of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

- by the substitution for the words "before all the six judges", of the words "before all the seven judges";
 by the substitution for the words "five or four",
- (2) by the substitution for the words "five or four", wherever those words occur therein of the words "six, five or four"; and
- (3) by the substitution for the words "by all the six judges"; of the words "by six judges".

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

No. 16 of 1908.

An Ordinance to amend the Ceylon Railway Benefit Association Ordinance, 1908.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :--

Short title.

Amendment of section 3 of Ordinance No. 16 of 1908.

Amendment of section 14 of the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 21 of the principal Ordinance. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Ceylon Railway Benefit Association Amendment Ordinance No. of 1936.

2 Section 3 of the Ceylon Railway Benefit Association Ordinance, 1908, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended by the substitution, for the words "next of kin or", of the words "to his widow and children or if there is no widow or child surviving him to his".

3 Section 14 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "business, and ", of the words "business, for the regulation of the extraordinary loans to be given to members under section 21 and for prescribing the conditions of such loans including the nature and situation of the immovable property that may be accepted as security, and ".

4 Section 21 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended in sub-section (1) thereof by the substitution in paragraph (b)of that sub-section, for all the words from "within" to "Colombo", of the words "within such limits as may be prescribed by rules made under section 14".

Objects and Reasons.

The objects of these amendments to the Ceylon Railway Benefit Association Ordinance, 1908 (No. 16 of 1908, as amended by No. 15 of 1931) are---

- to make it clear that on the death of a member who has not appointed a nominee, his widow and children shall be entitled, in preference to other next of kin or heirs, to receive the balance of his contributions to the funds and the donation given by the Association (Clause 2);
- (2) to leave it to the members to prescribe, by rules under section 14, the conditions subject to which extraordinary loans will be given and the nature and situation of the immovable property that will be accepted as security for such loans (Clauses 3 and 4).

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :--

An Ordinance to amend the Rubber Research Ordinance, 1930.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Rubber Research Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1936.

2 Section 4 of the Rubber Research Ordinance, 1930, is hereby amended by re-numbering sub-section (3) of that section as "(3A)" and by the addition immediately after re-numbered sub-section (3A) of the following sub-section which shall have effect as sub-section (3B) of that section :—

"(3B) The Board may apply for, purchase or otherwise acquire any patents, brevets d'invention, concessions and the like conferring an exclusive or non-exclusive or limited right to use, or any information as to, any invention which may seem capable of being used for any of the objects and purposes of the Board, or the acquisition of which may seem calculated directly or indirectly to assist the accomplishment of such objects and purposes; and may use, exercise, develop, grant licences in respect of, or otherwise turn to account, the property, rights and information so acquired."

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to extend the scope of section 4 of the Rubber Research Ordinance, 1930, and to confer on the Rubber Research Board power to apply for, purchase, or otherwise acquire, patents and kindred rights in industrial property.


