PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

In the Name of His Majesty EDWARD VIII., by the Grace of God of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India:

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir Reginald Edward Stubbs, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Territories and Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by Article 1 (2) of the Ceylon Importation of Textiles (Quotas) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1936, it is provided that the said Order in Council shall come into operation upon a date to be declared by the Governor by Proclamation in the Government Gazette:

Now know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation declare that the date hereof shall be the date upon which the said Order shall come into operation.

Given at Colombo, in the Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-fifth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-six.
