Whereas by the Ceylon Importation of Textiles (Quotas) Order in Council, 1934, (hereinafter called "the principal Order") provision was made to regulate the importation into Ceylon of certain textile goods:

And whereas it is expedient to amend the principal Order in the manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered by His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, as follows:-

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Ceylon Importation of Textiles (Quotas) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1936, and the principal Order and this Order may be cited together as the Ceylon Importation of Textiles (Quotas) Orders
- in Council, 1934 and 1936.

 (2) This Order shall be published in the Ceylon Government Gazette and shall come into operation upon a date to be declared by the Governor by proclamation in the Government Gazette.
 - 2. The following paragraph is hereby inserted at the end of Article 3 of the principal Order:
 - "The Interpretation Ordinance, 1901, of Ceylon shall, subject to the express provisions of this Order, and notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in that Ordinance, apply to this Order as if this Order were an Ordinance of the State Council of Ceylon."
- 3. For removing doubts it is hereby declared that the power to make regulations conferred upon the Governor by Article 10 of the Principal Order includes and has always included power by such regulations to define the circumstances in which textile goods shall be regarded as manufactured or not manufactured in any place.
- 4. Article 11 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by substituting the word "Governor" for the word "Government" in the first place where it occurs.
- 5. His Majesty hereby reserves to Himself, His Heirs and Successors power with the advice of His or Their Privy Council to revoke, alter or amend this Order as to Him or Them shall seem fit.
