GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1897.

REGULATION under sections 4 and 5 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance, 1897, made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Ordinance and by Article 93 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931.

REGULATION.

Where by virtue of any regulations in force under the Ordinance, the proper authority in any area is a Municipal or local authority, or an officer or person other than the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services, such proper authority shall, in all matters relating to the enforcement and execution of the regulations, carry out all such orders as may be issued by the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services.
