MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Coconut Products Ordinance,
No. 13 of 1935.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Coconut Products Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1936.

Amendment of
section 24 of
Ordinance
No. 13 of 1935.

2 Section 24 of the Coconut Products Ordinance, No. 13 of 1935, is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the renumbering of sub-sections (3) and (4) thereof as sub-sections (4) and (5), respectively ;

(2) by the insertion of the following new sub-section as sub-section (3) thereof :—

“ (3) Whenever the Board proposes to incur in any year any expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditure as set out in the budget for that year, the Board shall prepare and submit to the Minister a supplementary budget containing an estimate of the additional expenditure proposed to be incurred and of any increase anticipated in its estimated income as set out in the budget for that year.” ;

and,

(3) by the substitution in renumbered sub-section (4) for the words “ Every budget ”, of the words “ Every budget and every supplementary budget ”.

Objects and Reasons.

Section 24 (2) of the Coconut Products Ordinance, No. 13 of 1935, requires the Coconut Board to submit to the Minister in the month of November in each year a budget of the estimated income and expenditure of the Board for the next succeeding year. This budget is then laid on the table of the State Council for the information of the members thereof.

2. It may be necessary for the Board to incur in any year expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditure as set out in its budget for that year, but no provision is made in the Ordinance for the preparation of a supplementary budget.

The object of Clause 2 of this Bill is to add to section 24 of the principal Ordinance a new sub-section, which provides that, whenever the Board proposes to incur any additional expenditure for any year, it shall prepare a supplementary budget containing an estimate of such expenditure and of any anticipated increase in the income of the Board for that year. The supplementary budget, like the original budget, will be submitted to the Minister and laid on the table of the State Council.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

No. 26 of 1927.

An Ordinance to amend the Medical Ordinance, 1927, and to provide for the assumption and use of the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist in special cases.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Medical Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1936.

Amendment of
section 51 of
Ordinance
No. 26 of 1927.

2 Section 51 of the Medical Ordinance, 1927, (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Ordinance ”), is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) in sub-section (2) thereof, by the omission of the words “ and shall not assume or use the titles of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist unless he possesses the qualifications indicated in section 45 (1) (a) and section 45 (1) (b) ” ; and

(2) by the addition thereto of the following sub-section, which shall have effect as sub-section (3) of that section :—

“(3) A dentist shall not assume or use the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist unless he is registered in respect of a qualification set out in paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) of section 45 (1).”

3 Notwithstanding anything in section 51 of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance, any person who is registered or deemed to be registered as a dentist under the principal Ordinance in respect of a qualification set out in paragraph (c) of section 45 (1) of that Ordinance may assume and use the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist if he was registered or deemed to be registered under the principal Ordinance in respect of that qualification prior to the twenty-fifth day of April, 1933, being the date of the commencement of the Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933.

Provision for special cases.

Objects and Reasons.

Section 45 of the Medical Ordinance, 1927, provides that no person shall be registered as a dentist unless he is of good character and holds—

- (a) British qualifications, or
- (b) a diploma issued by the Council of the Ceylon Medical College, or
- (c) a diploma recognised by the Medical Council as a sufficient guarantee of competency as a dentist.

Section 51 (2) of that Ordinance was amended by the Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933, so as to prohibit the assumption or use of the title ‘dental surgeon’ or ‘surgeon dentist’ by any dentist who had not been registered in respect of a qualification under head (a) or head (b) referred to above. The Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933, came into operation on the 25th of April, 1933, and from that date a dentist registered in respect of a qualification under head (c) referred to above committed an offence if he assumed or used the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist. Any dentist registered in respect of a qualification under head (c) was thus compelled to discontinue the use of the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist even though he had lawfully used either title for some considerable time.

2. Three dentists who are now in practice were affected by the amendment of the law in 1933 and it is considered equitable that in these three cases the disabilities then imposed should be removed.

3. It is therefore proposed to legalise the assumption and use of the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist by any dentist who prior to the 25th April, 1933, was registered in respect of a qualification set out in paragraph (c) of section 45 (1) of the principal Ordinance and who by reason of the enactment of the Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933, was unable to assume or use the title of dental surgeon or surgeon dentist (Clause 3).

4. The opportunity has been taken to repeal the words added to section 51 (2) of the principal Ordinance by the Medical Amendment Ordinance, 1933, and to re-enact that amendment in the form of a new sub-section as it is not clear that the words added to sub-section (2) by the amending Ordinance of 1933 were intended to be inserted before, and not after, the proviso to that section.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public and the Colombo Electricity Supply Services for the Financial Year 1934-35.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1934-35) Ordinance, No. of 1936.

Supplementary Appropriation for the financial year 1934-1935.

2 In addition to the sums declared by the Appropriation Ordinance, No. 13 of 1934, to be payable out of the revenue and other funds of the Island and the Colombo Electricity Supply, the sums severally mentioned in the third column of the First and Second Schedules hereto and amounting to the sum of Ten million five hundred and eighty-nine thousand and nine hundred and eighty-nine rupees and fifty-five cents in the First Schedule and to the sum of Two thousand seven hundred and thirty-four rupees and thirty cents in the Second Schedule are hereby declared to be payable out of the revenue of this Island and the Colombo Electricity Supply respectively for the service of the financial year beginning on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-four, and ending on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and thirty-five, in respect of the several services respectively mentioned in the second column of each of those Schedules.
