An Ordinance to amend the Road Ordinance, 1861.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Amendment Ordinance, No. 11 of 1936.

Amendment of section 19 of Ordinance No. 10 of 1861.

2 Section 19 of the Road Ordinance, 1861, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "expenses necessary for the management", of the words "expenses necessary for the management and advertisement ".

Passed in Council the Seventeenth day of November, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-six.
