(14) A portion of the bed of the stream called Kirigala-deniyedola, situated at Walandure in Kuruwiti korale, about ‡ mile in length, within the following boundaries:—

North by right bank. East by lot 227 in V. P. 333. South by left bank. West by confluence of Gahalawatte-dola.
