Lease of Crown Rubber Lands.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Assistant Government Agent, Kegalla, will receive sealed tenders for the lease of the right to take the produce of the rubber plantations for the year 1937, in the under-mentioned Crown lands which have been duly registered under the Rubber Control Ordinance.
