An Ordinance to amend the Cemeteries and Burials Ordinance, 1899.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Cemeteries and Burials (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 14 of 1937.

Insertion of new section 37A in Ordinance No. 9 of 1899.

2 The Cemeteries and Burials Ordinance, 1899, is hereby amended by the addition immediately after section 37 of the following new section, which shall have effect as section 37A of that Ordinance :—

Corpse not to be removed from burial ground without authority.

37A. No corpse buried in any part of any burial ground shall be removed from its place of burial without the authority of the District Court within the jurisdiction of which such burial ground is situated: Provided that nothing in this section shall affect or limit the provisions of section 365 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898.
