Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

#### No. 21 of 1937.

#### An Ordinance to amend the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government Amendment Ordinance, No. 21 of 1937.

Amendment of section 55 of Ordinance No. 11 of 1920.

- 2 Section 55 of the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920, is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (1) by the renumbering of that section as sub-section (1) of section 55; and
  - (2) by the addition of the following new sub-section as sub-section (2) of that section:—
    - "(2) Subject to such directions as may be given by the Governor from time to time by Order published in the Gazette, each District Council shall be the administrative authority for the purposes of the protection of any principal thoroughfares that may be situate within the administrative limits of that Council, and shall be entitled for such purposes to exercise or perform, in relation to any such principal thoroughfare, any of the powers or duties conferred or imposed by sections 84 to 104 (both inclusive), relating to buildings along thoroughfares, obstructions to thoroughfares, encroachments on thoroughfares, injuries to thoroughfares and nuisances on thoroughfares."

#### DRAFT ORDINANCES.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

#### An Ordinance to amend the Registration of Business Names Ordinance, No. 6 of 1918.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Business Names Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1937.
- Substitution of new section for section 9 of Ordinance Ne. 6 of 1918.
- 2 Section 9 of the Registration of Business Names Ordinance, No. 6 of 1918, is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

Disability of persons in default. 9. (1) Where any firm or person required by this Ordinance to furnish a statement of particulars or of any change in particulars in respect of any business shall have made default in so doing, then the rights of that defaulter under or arising out of any contract in relation to that business made or entered into by or on behalf of such defaulter at any time while he is in default shall not be enforceable by action or other legal proceeding either in the business name or otherwise:

Provided that-

- (a) the defaulter may apply to the court for relief against the disability imposed by this section, and the court, on being satisfied that the default was accidental, or due to inadvertence or some other sufficient cause, or that on other grounds it is just and equitable to grant relief, may grant such relief either generally, or as respects any particular contracts, on condition of the costs of the application being paid by the defaulter, unless the court otherwise orders, and on such other conditions, if any, as the court may impose; but such relief shall not be granted except on such service and such publication of notice of the application as the court may order, nor shall relief be given in respect of any contract if any party to the contract proves to the satisfaction of the court that, if the provisions of this Ordinance had been complied with, he would not have entered into the contract;
- (b) nothing herein contained shall prejudice the rights of any other parties as against the defaulter in respect of such contract as aforesaid;
- (c) if any action or proceeding shall be commenced by any other party against the defaulter to enforce the rights of such party in respect of such contract, nothing herein contained shall preclude the defaulter from enforcing in that action or proceeding, by way of counterclaim set off or otherwise, such rights as he may have against that party in respect of such contract.
- (2) In this section, "court" means the court in which any action or other legal proceeding to enforce a contract is commenced by a defaulter.

#### Objects and Reasons.

Section 9 of the Registration of Business Names Ordinance, No. 6 of 1918, provides that where a firm or person required by that Ordinance to furnish a statement of particulars or of any change in particulars relating to any business has made default in so doing, a contract entered into by or on behalf of the defaulter in relation to that business shall not be enforceable at any time while he is in default by action or other legal proceeding either in the business name or otherwise.

This section is modelled on section 8 of the Registration of Business Names Act, 1916, but does not reproduce the proviso to the English section, which enacts that a court can relieve a person or firm of the disability created by the section in specified circumstances. Attention was drawn to this omission by the Supreme Court in the case of Arunachalam Chettiar v. Ramanathan Chettiar (1935, 37 New Law Reports, page 263).

2. The object of this Bill is to repeal section 9 of the Registration of Business Names Ordinance, No. 6 of 1918, and to substitute in its place a new section which reproduces the proviso to section 8 of the English Act. The opportunity has also been taken to redraft the substantive part of the section so as to remove the ambiguity in phraseology to which attention was drawn by the Privy Council in the case of David v. de Silva (1933, 35 New Law Reports, page 201).

An Ordinance to amend the Colombo Municipal Council (Constitution) Ordinance, No. 60 of 1935.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:

This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Municipal Council (Constitution) Amendment Ordinance, No. 1937.

Section 2 of the Colombo Municipal Council (Constitution) Ordinance, No. 60 of 1935, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended in subsection (2), paragraphs (a) and (b), by the substitution of the word "building" for the word "dwelling-house" wherever that word occurs in those paragraphs.

Short title.

Amendment of section 2 (2) of No. 60 of 1935. Amendment of section 14 of the principal Ordinance.

- 3 Section 14 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—
  - (1) in sub-section (2)—
    - (a) by the insertion of the words "Except in the case provided for in paragraph (g) (v) of this sub-section" at the beginning of paragraph (f):

(b) by the repeal of paragraph (g) and the substitution of the following paragraph therefor:—

"(g)(i) is the owner of qualifying property situated within the limits of the Municipality; or

(ii) is the tenant of qualifying property situated within the limits of the ward of the Municipality in which he is resident on the said date; or

(iii) is a boarder in a hotel, club or boardinghouse within the limits of the ward
of the Municipality in which he is
resident on the said date paying a sum
of not less than ten rupees a month
for board and lodging combined and
has, for a continuous period of at least
six months in the period of eighteen
months immediately prior to the said
date, been a boarder in a hotel, club
or boarding-house within the limits of
any ward of the Municipality paying
a sum of not less than ten rupees a
month for board and lodging combined;
or

(iv) has an income of not less than fifteen rupees a month; or

- (v) is the owner of qualifying property within the limits of a ward of the Municipality but is not resident within the Municipality on the said date or being so resident has failed to comply with the requirements of residence prescribed by paragraph (f).";
- (2) by the repeal of sub-section (3) and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—
  - "(3) (a) For the purposes of paragraph (g) (i) of the preceding sub-section—

"owner" includes a fiduciary and a person entitled to a usufruct for life but does not include

a usufructuary mortgagee;
"qualifying property" means any land, house,
tenement or building bearing a separate
number in the Assessment Book of the
Municipal Council and assessed at an annual
value of not less than ten rupees.

(b) For the purposes of paragraph (g) (ii) of the preceding sub-section—

"tenant" means the person in possession or occupation whether as lessee, sub-lessee, tenant or sub-tenant of any qualifying property under any contract of letting and hiring relating to that qualifying property;

"qualifying property" means any land, house, tenement or building, whether bearing a separate number in the Assessment Book of the Municipal Council or not, or part of such land, house, tenement or building and in respect of which the person in possession or occupation pays a monthly rent of not less than one rupee.

(c) For the purposes of paragraph (g) (v) of the preceding sub-section—

"owner" includes a fiduciary and a person entitled to a usufruct for life but does not include a usufructuary mortgagee;

"qualifying property" means any land, house, tenement or building bearing a separate number in the Assessment Book of the Municipal Council and assessed at an annual value of not less than six hundred rupees.";

- (3) by the repeal of sub-section (4) and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—
  - "(4) Where two or more persons are owners of any qualifying property, the annual value at which such qualifying property is assessed shall, for the purposes of this section only, be divided in the proportion of their several shares in that qualifying property; and, if the amount of the annual value which corresponds to the share of any owner is equal to or exceeds ten rupees or six hundred rupees, as the case may be, that owner shall, for the purposes of paragraph (g) (i) or paragraph (g) (v) of sub-section (2) respectively, be deemed to be an owner of qualifying property, notwithstanding the fact that he owns a share only in such property and that such share is not separately numbered in the Assessment Book of the Municipal Council.":
- (4) by the repeal of sub-section (5), and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—
  - "(5) Where two or more persons are tenants of any qualifying property, the monthly rental payable under the contract of letting and hiring relating to that qualifying property shall, for the purposes of this section only, be divided in the proportion of the amounts respectively payable as monthly rental by each tenant under the contract of letting and hiring relating to that qualifying property; and if, upon such division, the amount of the monthly rental payable by any tenant is equal to or exceeds one rupee, that tenant shall, for the purposes of paragraph (g) (ii) of sub-section (2) be deemed to be a tenant of qualifying property, notwithstanding the fact that the qualifying property is jointly tenanted.";
- (5) in sub-section (6), by the addition of the following proviso at the end and in continuation thereof:—

"Provided however that in the case of a person who in any year is qualified to vote under paragraph (g) (v) of sub-section (2) his name shall be entered in the new or revised list of persons qualified to vote prepared for the ward in which his qualifying property is situated on the date of the preparation or revision, as the case may be, of such list for that year."; and

- (6) in sub-section (10)-
  - (a) by the insertion in paragraph (a), between the words "qualifying property" and the word "shall", of the words "under paragraphs (g) (i) or (g) (ii) of sub-section (2) respectively"; and
  - (b) by the insertion in paragraph (b), between the words "sub-sections (3)" and the words "(4), (5), (8) and (9)" of the words "paragraphs (a) and (b)".
- 4 Section 15 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended in sub-section (4) by the insertion at the end and in continuation thereof of the following words "or a person who is qualified to vote and whose name appears in the list of persons duly qualified to vote in force for the time being by reason of the qualification specified in paragraph (g) (v) of section 14 (2).".

Amendment of section 15 (4) of the principal Ordinance.

- ${\bf 5}$  Section 21 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—
  - (1) in sub-section (1)-
    - (a) by the repeal of paragraphs (e), (f), (g) and (h);
    - (b) by re-numbering paragraph (i) as paragraph (e);
    - (c) by the repeal of the words "or who requests that his name shall be erased" at the end of the re-numbered paragraph (e) (i);
    - (d) by the repeal of the words "and who has made due application for that purpose" at the end of the re-numbered paragraph (e) (ii);
    - (e) by the repeal of the words "and who has made due application for that purpose" at the end of the re-numbered paragraph (e) (iii); and

Amendment of section 21 of the principal Ordinance.

- (2) by the repeal of sub-section (2) and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—
  - (2) In preparing or revising any such lists, the Commissioner may make such inquiries as he shall deem necessary, either by himself or by any officer appointed by him for that purpose. He may, for the same purpose, require any person to make a declaration in writing of his annual income and, where the owner of any house, building or land situated within the limits of the Municipality is resident outside such limits, may require such owner to furnish him with a declaration of the nature of the title on which such house, building or land is held. Any person intentionally giving any false information in connection with any such inquiry or refusing or failing to furnish any declaration herein specified for the space of one week from the date on which he shall have been required to do so or intentionally making a false or incorrect declaration shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees."

Amendment of section 23 of the principal Ordinance. 6 Section 23 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-section (1) and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor:—

Claims and objections.

"(1) Every person duly qualified in any year to vote or to be elected or whose name was inserted in the lists for the previous year or whose name was marked with the double qualification mark in the lists for the previous year and who finds at the time when the new or revised lists are open to inspection under section 22 that his name is omitted from such lists or is in a wrong list or is not marked with the double qualification mark and who claims to have his name inserted or transferred to a list for another ward or so marked (such person being hereinafter referred to as "the claimant") may apply to the Commissioner to have his name inserted or transferred or so marked."

Amendment of section 25 of the principal Ordinance.

  - (1) by the insertion between the word "insertion" and the words "or omission" of the word "transfer"; and

#### Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to vary the qualifications of voters and councillors prescribed by the Colombo Municipal Council (Constitution) Ordinance, No. 60 of 1935, and to amend that Ordinance so as to give effect to the recommendations of the Municipal Council of Colombo as modified by the Executive Committee of Local Administration.

- 2. Section 14 (3) of the principal Ordinance defines "tenant" as the person who, in law, is responsible to the owner of the property for the payment of the rent. This restrictive definition had the effect of excluding from the voters' lists a large number of persons who were in occupation of qualifying property but in the capacity of sub-lessees and and sub-tenants. It is proposed to enfranchise all those who, under the existing law, are deprived of a vote by reason of the fact that they are unable to establish contracts of direct lease or tenancy under the owners of the properties which they occupy. Further, the definition of "qualifying property" in the same section as property in respect of which a rate is paid had the effect of depriving occupants of Government and Municipal property of the right to vote. The new section proposed in this Bill will restore the vote to all those who are disfranchised on the ground last mentioned.
- 3. New section 14 (Clause 3) provides that where the ownership of qualifying property is the basis of the claim for inclusion in the voters' lists, such property must be assessed at an annual value of not less than ten rupees. Under the existing law the criterion is the payment of an annual rate of ten rupees. In the case of a tenant of qualifying property, who will in the future include a sub-tenant and any person in possession of such property under any contract of letting and hiring relating thereto, the basis of the claim for inclusion in the voters' lists will be the payment of a monthly rental of not less than one rupee. The new section further provides

for the enfranchisement of the non-resident owner of property within the Municipality provided that the assessed annual value of such property is not less than six hundred rupees. Such a non-resident owner will, however, be ineligible for election as a Councillor. Provision has also been made for enfranchising boarders in clubs, hotels and boarding houses and all persons who have an income of not less than fifteen rupees a month.

- 4. The Bill deals with two other points on which an amendment of the law was suggested by the Colombo Municipal Council:—
  - (a) the abandonment of the system of registration of voters on an application basis and a reversion to the old system under which such registration was undertaken and completed by the staff of the Council; and
  - (b) the substitution of the word "building" for the word "dwelling-house" in sections 2 (2) (a) and (2 (2) (b) of the principal Ordinance in order to remove difficulties arising from a restrictive interpretation of the word "dwelling-house".
- 5. Section 14 (3) of the principal Ordinance defines "owner" as including a fiduciary but as excluding a person entitled to a life-interest in qualifying property. As there is no real difference between a fiduciary and a usufructuary for life in regard to the right to enjoy the fruits of immovable property, the opportunity has been taken to re-define "owner" so as to include a usufructuary for life.
