DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

G 1384

An Ordinance to make provision for the dissolution of the Village Committee of the Akkaraipattu Central Subdivision in the Batticaloa District, for the election of a new Village Committee in place of that Committee, and for other purposes connected therewith or incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Akkaraipattu Village Committee Ordinance, No. of 1937.

Power to give directions for the election of a new village committee.

- 2 (1) For the purpose of dissolving the existing village committee of the Akkaraipattu Subdivision and causing a new village committee to be elected in place thereof, it shall be lawful for the Governor at any time after the commencement of this Ordinance—
 - (a) by an Order, which shall be published in the Gazette and shall be deemed for all purposes to be an Order under section 14A of the Village Communities Ordinance, to redivide that Subdivision into new wards; and
 - (b) by any subsequent Order or Orders published in the Gazette, to give directions for the election of a new village committee and all such other directions, whether supplementary to or in modification of the provisions of the Village Communities Ordinance, as may from time to time be necessary for the purposes of that election, with a view to providing for any special circumstances or to determining or adjusting any question or matter for the determination or adjustment of which no provision or effective provision is made by that Ordinance.
- (2) No Order made by the Governor under this section or act done under or by virtue of such Order shall be deemed to be in derogation of, or to affect in any way, the legal status, powers, functions, or duties of the existing village committee of the Akkaraipattu Subdivision or any member thereof.

Power to appoint date on which the new village committee is to succeed the existing village committee. 3 Upon the completion of the election of a new village committee in pursuance of directions given under section 2, the Governor may, by Order under this section published in the Gazette, appoint the date on which the existing committee of the Akkaraipattu Subdivision shall go out of office; and upon the date so appointed, notwithstanding anything contained in the Village Communities Ordinance, the existing village committee shall go out of office, and the new village committee shall come into office in place thereof.

Status and term of office of the new village committee.

- 4 The new village committee of the Akkaraipattu Sub-division—
 - (a) shall, notwithstanding that it is elected in accordance with any directions under section 2, modifying or supplementing the provisions of the Village Communities Ordinance or relating to any question or matter for which no provision or effective provision is made by that Ordinance, be deemed for all purposes to be a village committee duly elected under that Ordinance; and ...
 - (b) shall remain in office for the unexpired portion of the period for which the existing village committee of the Akkaraipattu Subdivision would have remained in office if the provisions of this Ordinance authorising the dissolution of the existing village committee had not been enacted.

Interpretation.

- ${f 5}$ In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - "Akkaraipattu Subdivision" means the Akkaraipattu Central Subdivision of the Chief Headman's Division of Akkaraipattu in the Batticaloa District of the Eastern Province;

"existing village committee", in relation to the Akkaraipattu Subdivision, means the village committee elected in place of the village committee which went out of office by effluxion of time, in accordance with the provisions of the Village Communities Ordinance, on the last day of June, 1936;

"new village committee", in relation to the Akkaraipattu Subdivision, means the village committee to be elected in place of the existing village committee in accordance with such directions as may be given by the Governor by Order under section 2;

by the Governor by Order under section 2; "Village Communities Ordinance" means the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

Objects and Reasons.

The Akkaraipattu Central Subdivision of the Akkaraipattu Chief Headman's Division of the Batticaloa District, which was originally defined by Proclamation in 1927, was redefined in February, 1936, and was divided in the following month into nine wards by an Order under section 14A of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924. The basis on which the Subdivision was divided into wards was not acceptable to a large body of the inhabitants, who therefore declined to take any part in the general election which was held in the months of May and June, 1936. As a result, four of the nine wards were left unrepresented; and as that section of the inhabitants has also refused to accept nomination to any of the vacant seats, the Committee has hitherto consisted only of five members who assumed the duties of their office after a Chairman was nominated by the Governor in April this year.

2. As all efforts to bring about a settlement have proved unsuccessful, it has now been decided that the Committee should be dissolved, that the Subdivision should be redivided into a larger number of wards, and that a new Committee should be elected on the basis of the new wards. For abolishing the existing wards and redividing the Subdivision into new wards during the term of office of the existing Committee, for electing a new Committee before the dissolution of the existing Committee, and for dissolving the existing Committee in this manner, specially power has to be taken.

3. The object of Clause 2 of this Bill is to give the Governor power by Order published in the Gazette to redivide the Subdivision into new wards and to issue all such directions as may be necessary for the election of a new Committee to take the place of the Committee that is to be dissolved. The necessary provision for appointing the date for the dissolution of the existing Committee and for the assumption of office

by the new Committee is made in Clause 3.

4. Clause 4 declares that the new Committee elected in place of the existing Committee shall be deemed for all purposes to be duly elected under the provisions of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924, and that it shall remain in office for the unexpired period of the term of office of the existing Committee.
