(13) Any breach of any of the terms and conditions shall render the permit liable to immediate cancellation without compensation, on the orders of the Government Agent or his Assistant.

(14) On the expiry or cancellation of the permit the lessee shall deliver quiet possession of the said land to any person acting under the orders of the Government Agent or his Assistant, and such person may on such expiry or cancellation enter upon the said land or premises, and take possession on behalf of the Government Agent or his Assistant.

(15) The lessee shall not have or make any claim for compensation for improvements effected or expenses incurred, or for damages, or for any other cause or reason whatever.

(16) The lessee shall not have any claim to preferential sale or lease of the land by reason of having held it on this permit.

The Government Agent reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders.
