Notification No. 1.

REGULATIONS under sections 8 and 42 of the Tea Control Ordinance, No. 12 of 1938, made by the Executive Committee of Agriculture and Lands. 66 33\*<sup>2</sup> 136

Colombo, March 29, 1938.

REGULATIONS RELATING TO RETURNS.

1. The return to be furnished under section 8 (1) of the Ordinance by the proprietor of every land planted with tea on March 31, 1938, which was not registered under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, shall-

(a) be made on or before the Second day of May, 1938, and
(b) be substantially in such one of the Forms A and B in the schedule as may be appropriate to the case.

2. (1) The return to be furnished under section 8 (2) of the Ordinance by every person who is permitted or granted authority to plant tea in accordance with section 27 (1) (c) or section 28 of the Ordinance shall—

(a) be made within a period of one month from the date on which the planting of tea under the authority so granted is completed, and (b) be substantially in such one of the Forms A<sup>1</sup> and B<sup>1</sup> in the schedule as may be appropriate to the case.

The return which any person registered as the proprietor of any estate or small holding or of any part of any estate or small holding, or any person registered as the proprietor of any estate of small holding of 5 any person claiming to be registered as such proprietor may be required under section 8 (3) of the Ordinance to furnish to the Controller in any period of assessment shall be substantially in such one of the Forms A<sup>2</sup> and B<sup>2</sup> in the schedule as may be appropriate to the case.

4. All rules relating to returns to be furnished by proprietors of estates and small holdings, made under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, are hereby rescinded.



#### REGULATIONS FELATING TO REGISTERS.

1. The register of estates and the register of small holdings required to be kept by the Controller under section 9 (1) of the Ordinance shall be in the Forms in the Schedule.

2. The registered proprietor of every estate and of every small holding shall notify to the Controller any change of his address or of the name, extent or ownership of the estate or small holding, or the occurrence of any circumstance affecting the accuracy of the particulars contained in any return furnished in respect of the estate or small holding under the Ordinance or under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933.

3. Every notification required by regulation 2 shall be made to the Controller in writing within a period of ten days from the date of the change or the occurrence of the circumstance, as the case may be, referred to in that regulation.

4. The Controller may at any time either on his own initiative or as a result of any notification received by him under regulation 2 amend any entry in any register kept for the purposes of the Ordinance if he is satisfied, after such inquiry as he may deem necessary, that such entry is incorrect.

5. Where any entry in any register kept for the purposes of the Ordinance is amended as a result of any notification received by the Controller under regulation 2—-

- (a) if the amendment relates to any change in the address of the registered proprietor of any estate or small holding, a fee of one rupee shall be paid to the Controller by that proprietor.
- (b) if the amendment relates to any change in the ownership of any estate or small holding, a fee of one rupee shall be paid to the Controller by each person who is, as the result of such amendment, registered as proprietor of that estate or small holding.

6. All rules relating to registers of estates and small holdings, made under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, are hereby reseinded.

REGULATIONS FOR THE DIVISION OF CEYLON INTO PLANTING DISTRICTS.

1. The Western, Central, and North-Western Provinces, the Provinces of Uva and Sabaragamuwa, and the Galle and Matara Districts of the Southern Province, shall be divided into planting districts as follows :-

(1) Agrapatna Planting District-

Subject as hereinafter provided, the allowance to be made for the immature areas of any estate referred to in section 12 (1) of the Ordinance shall be computed according to the rules under sections 14, 15, and 35 of the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, published by Notification No. 24 in *Gazette* No. 8,040 of March 23, 1934, as last amended by the rule published by Notification No. 51 in *Gazette* No. 8,240 of August 21, 1936 : Provided, however, that nothing in the rules aforesaid shall entitle any person to obtain a special assessment of the

immature areas of any such estate.

2. The date on or before which the registered proprietor of any estate may apply to have the standard crop of that estate specially reassessed under section 12 (2) of the Ordinance shall be May 2, 1938.

3. The fee to be paid by the registered proprietor of any estate before the standard crop of that estate is specially reassessed under section 12 (2) of the Ordinance shall, in the case of an estate of the extent indicated in column 1 of the Table hereunder, be of the amount indicated in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Table :—

(1) Where a special reassessment of the standard crop of any estate is to be made in the period of ascessment commencing on April 1, 1938, such special reassessment shall be made after an inspection of the estate and shall, as required by section 12 (2) of the Ordinance, be based on the quantity of made tea which could on April 1, 1938, reasonably have been estimated to be the annual output from an acre of the mature areas of that estate increased by an allowance for the immature areas of that estate :

Provided that in no case shall the standard crop of any estate as so reassessed be greater than it would be if it were assessed according to the maximum rate provided in regulation 4 for the planting district in which that estate is situated. (2) The allowance referred to in paragraph (1) for the immature areas of any estate shall be computed in the following

manner :-

- (a) each immature area shall be inspected and the standard crop of that area for the period of assessment commencing on April 1, 1938, shall be assessed on the basis of the quantity of made tea which can reasonably be estimated to be the output from an acre of that area for that period;
- (b) at the time when the assessment referred to in paragraph (a) is made, the standard crop of that estate for each succeeding period of assessment until that area has reached maturity in accordance with the provisions of Schedule I., shall also be assessed on the basis of the average quantity of made tea which can reasonably be estimated to be the output from an acre of that area for each such period ;
- (c) the allowance to be made in respect of any immature area for any period of that area for each such period;
  (c) the allowance to be made in respect of any immature area for any period of assessment shall be the quantity of made tea estimated under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) in respect of that area for that period. Provided, however, that in no case shall the allowance in respect of any immature area for any period of assessment be greater than it would be if it were computed according to the maximum rate provided in regulation 4 for the planting district in which that area is situated.

6. Except in the case for which provision is made in regulation 7, where an assessment of the standard crop of any estate which was not registered under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, is to be made under section 12 (4) of the Ordinance, such assessment shall be made after an inspection of that estate, and the allowance to be made for the immature areas of that estate for the purposes of sections 12 (4) and 12 (5) of the Ordinance shall be computed in the following manner :--

(a) each immature area shall be inspected and the standard crop of that area for the period of assessment in which that estate is registered shall be assessed on the basis of the quantity of made tea which can reasonably be estimated to be the output from an acre of that area for that period;

- (b) at the time when the assessment referred to in paragraph (a) is made, the standard crop of that estate for each succeeding period of assessment until that area has reached maturity in accordance with the provisions of Schedule I., shall also be assessed on the basis of the average quantity of made tea which can reasonably be estimated to be the output from an acre of that area for each such period;
- (c) the allowance to be made in respect of any immature area for any period of assessment shall be the quantity of made tea estimated under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) in respect of any immature area for any period of assessment shall be the quantity of made tea estimated under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) in respect of any immature area for any period. Provided, however, that in no case shall the allowance in respect of any immature area for any period of assessment be greater than it would be if it were computed according to the rate provided in regulation 9 for the planting district in which that area is situated.

7. (1) Where at the time of the registration under the Ordinance of any estate, that estate does not comprise any mature areas, the standard crop of that estate shall after an inspection of the estate, be first assessed for the period of assessment in which that estate first becomes entitled to an assessment in accordance with the provisions of Schedule II.
(2) At the time when the assessment referred to in paragraph (1) is made, the standard crop of the estate for each

succeeding period of assessment until the estate has reached maturity in accordance with the provisions of Schedule II., shall also be assessed.

shall also be assessed.
(3) Every assessment made under paragraphs (1) and (2) shall, in respect of each period of assessment, be based on the average quantity of made tea which can reasonably be estimated to be the output from an acre of that estate for that period. Provided, however, that in no case shall the standard crop of any Estate as assessed under this regulation be greater than it would be if it were assessed according to the rate provided in regulation 9 for the planting district in which that Estate is situated.

8. In regulations 6 and 7, any reference to an estate includes a reference to a part of an estate.

9. For the purposes of regulations 6 (c) and 7 (3) the rate applicable to each planting district of the Island shall be the rate specified in the Table hereunder for that district :—

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE ASSESSMENT OF THE STANDARD CROPS OF ESTATES AND SMALL HOLDINGS WHICH HAVE BEEN AMALGAMATED OR SUB-DIVIDED.

1. Where any registered estate is divided into two or more portions and any of these portions is subsequently registered as a separate estate, the standard crop of that portion shall continue to be determined in the manner in which its standard crop was determined when it formed part of the original estate.

2. Where any registered small holding is divided into two or more portions and any of these portions is subsequently registered as a separate small holding, the standard crop of that portion shall continue to be determined in the manner in which its standard crop was determined when it formed part of the original small holding.

3. Where any area of land which is registered as an estate or as part of an estate is subsequently for any reason registered as a small holding or as part of a small holding, the standard crop of that area shall continue to be determined in the manner in which its standard crop was determined when it was registered as an estate or as part of an estate.

4. Where any area of land which is registered as a small holding or as part of a small holding is subsequently for any reason registered as an estate or as part of an estate, the standard crop of that area shall continue to be determined in the manner in which its standard crop was determined when it was registered as a small holding or as part of a small holding.

REGULATIONS RELATING TO APPEALS.

1. Every appeal under the provisions of the Ordinance shall be-

- (a) made by a written statement in English, substantially in the form set out in the Schedule to these regulations, and
- (b) accompanied by a fee of five rupees in the case of an appeal preferred in relation to an estate and one rupee in the case of an appeal preferred in relation to a small holding.

2. Every statement of appeal shall be sent by registered post to the Controller within fourteen days (exclusive of Sundays and public holidays) of the service of the notice communicating the assessment, decision or order against which the appeal is preferred.

3. No statement of appeal which is sent to the Controller after the expiry of the period mentioned in regulation 2 shall be entertained by the Board of Appeal : Provided, however, that it shall be competent to the Board of Appeal in its discretion, on application made by the appellant in that behalf, to entertain such statement of appeal if it is satisfied that the appellant was prevented by causes not within his control from complying with the provisions of regulation 2.

4. Appeals shall be listed and heard as far as possible in the order in which the statements of appeal are received.

5. The appellant and the Controller shall be entitled to appear at the hearing of an appeal, in person or by representative authorized in writing for that purpose.

6. The appellant or his representative shall be entitled to be heard in support of the appeal, and the Controller or his representative, to be heard against the appeal, and where any argument is heard against the appeal, the appellant or his representative shall have the right of reply.

7. The Board of Appeal may, during the hearing of any appeal, call for such evidence oral or documentary as to it may seem necessary for the proper adjudication of any matter or matters at issue.

(1) The decision of the Board of Appeal, whether it be given at the close of the hearing or on some day thereafter, shall be reduced to writing and dated as of the date on which it is given, and formal notice thereof shall be served on the appellant within three days of such date by the Controller in the manner provided in the Ordinance. (2) Every decision of the Board of Appeal shall, when reduced to writing, be signed by the Chairman or the member

presiding at the hearing, as the case may be.

9. (1) The Board of Appeal shall not be deemed to be properly constituted at the hearing of any appeal unless at least two members are present.

(2) The Chairman, who shall be elected at the first meeting of the Board, shall preside at all meetings at which he is present ; and in the absence of the Chairman from any meeting one of the other members (chosen by agreement or by lot) shall preside.

10. (1) All matters, brought up in appeal, or preliminary to or connected with any appeal, shall be decided by a majority of the members of the Board of Appeal present at the hearing.

(2) If the Board of Appeal at the hearing consists of two members only, in the event of an equality of votes on any matter, the decision shall be taken at a meeting when all three members are present.

All books, plans, documents, papers, and other productions produced before the Board of Appeal for the 11. purposes of any appeal shall, unless otherwise directed by the Board, remain in the custody of the Controller.

12. The remuneration payable to each member of the Board of Appeal shall be fifty rupees for a working day of over two hours, and twenty-five rupees for a working day of two hours and under.

All rules relating to appeals made under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, are hereby 13. rescinded.

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE ISSUE OF TEA COUPONS, EXPORT LICENCES, &C.

1. Every tea coupon to be issued by the Controller under section 20 of the Ordinance to the registered proprietors of estates and small holdings shall be in such of the forms in the schedule as is appropriate to the case.

2. Every export licence to be issued by the Controller under section 21 of the Ordinance shall be in the appropriate Form in the Schedule.

3. Every special export licence to be issued by the Controller under sections 22 and 23 of the Ordinance shall be in the appropriate Form in the Schedule.

4. (1) The Controller may in his discretion issue in the first instance in exchange for any tea coupon, a credit note in the Form in the Schedule to any person to whom such coupon has been issued or duly endorsed. (2) Any credit note so issued shall be transferable in the same manner as a tea coupon; and any person to whom a

credit note has been issued or duly endorsed may obtain in exchange therefor as many sub-credit notes in the Form in the Schedule for smaller amounts (not exceeding in the aggregate the amount represented by the credit note) as he may require or as the Controller in his discretion may decide to issue.

(3) Any person to whom a credit note or a sub-credit note has been issued or duly endorsed shall be entitled to obtain from the Controller in exchange therefor an export licence authorizing the export from Ceylon of the quantity of made tea represented by the credit note or sub-credit note, as if the credit note or the sub-credit note were a tea coupon issued under section 20 of the Ordinance.

5. Every credit note issued in exchange for any tea coupon shall cease to be valid at the time at which that coupon would have ceased to be valid if no credit note had been issued in exchange therefor; and every sub-credit note issued in exchange for any credit note shall cease to be valid at the time at which that credit note would have ceased to be valid if no sub-credit note had been issued in exchange therefor.

6. The holder of any credit note or sub-credit note who has not, before that credit note or sub-credit note ceases to 6. The holder of any credit note or sub-credit note who has not, before that credit note or sub-credit note ceases to be valid under regulation 5, obtained in exchange therefor an export licence in accordance with the provisions of regulation 4 (3), may, on application made to the Controller within fourteen days next following the date on which that credit note or sub-credit note, as the case may be, ceases to be valid, obtain in exchange therefor a special export licence authorizing the export from Ceylon of the quantity of made tea represented by that credit note or sub-credit note. Provided that no such special export licence shall on or after April 1, 1939, be issued in exchange for any credit note or sub-credit note unless it is established to the satisfaction of the Controller—

- (a) that the holder of that credit note or sub-credit note has in his possession the amount of made tea represented
- by that credit note or sub-credit note, as the case may be; and (b) that such made tea was produced in the period of assessment in which that credit note or sub-credit note, as the case may be, was issued.

7. All rules relating to tea coupons, export licences, special export licences, credit notes and sub-credit notes, made under the Tea (Control of Export) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1933, are hereby rescinded.

REGULATIONS under sections 29 and 42 of the Tea Control Ordinance, No. 12 of 1938, made by the Executive Committee of Agriculture and Lands.

Colombo, March 29, 1938.

REGULATIONS FOR REPLANTING.

1. The permit which the proprietor of any estate or small holding is required to obtain from the Controller to authorize the replanting of tea on that estate or small holding under section 29 of the Ordinance shall be substantially in the Form G 1 in the Schedule.

2. The replanting of tea on any estate or small holding under the authority of a permit under regulation 1 shall be completed on or before December 31 of the year following that in which such permit is issued.

3. Every proprietor of an estate or small holding to whom a permit under regulation 1 is issued shall within a period of one month from the date on which the replanting under the authority of such permit is completed report to the Controller in writing the fact that such replanting has been completed and the date on which it was completed.


REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE PLANTING AND MAINTENANCE OF NURSERIES.

1. The licence required by section 30 (1) of the Ordinance for the planting of tea for the purposes of a nursery on land which was not planted with tea on March 31, 1938, shall be substantially in the Form G 2 in the Schedule.

2. The date from and after which no tea nursery existing on March 31, 1938, shall be maintained, except upon a licence issued by the Controller under section 30 (2) of the Ordinance, shall be August 1, 1938.
