PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 24 of 1938.

An Ordinance further to amend the Ceylon State Mortgage Bank Ordinance, 1931.

A. CALDECOTT.

BE. it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

- 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Ceylon State Mortgage Bank (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 24 of 1938. Short title.
- 2 Section 14 of the Ceylon State Mortgage Bank Ordinance, 1931, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby amended— Amendment of section 14 of Ordinance No. 16 of 1931.
- (a) by the re-numbering of that section as sub-section (1) of section 14 ;
- (b) by the addition at the end of re-numbered sub-section (1) of the following new sub-section which shall have effect as sub-section (2) of that section :—
- (2) Where a Director who has been appointed the Chairman of the Board for any year, is granted leave of absence for any period during that year, the Governor shall make a new appointment, from among the Directors, of a Chairman for that period.
- 3 (1) Section 21 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "prescribe the scale for their remuneration and travelling expenses.", of the following :— Amendment of section 21 of the principal Ordinance.
- "prescribe by rules made under section 91 the scales for their remuneration and travelling charges :
- Provided, however, that it shall be lawful—
- (a) for the Board to determine by resolution ; or
- (b) for the manager, if, with the approval of the Governor, he is specially or generally authorised thereto by the Board under section 19 (1), to determine,
- the remuneration and travelling charges to be paid to any such person in respect of the valuation of any property."
- (2) The amendment made by sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have had effect on and after the fifteenth day of April, 1935.
- 4 The following new section shall be inserted immediately after section 36 of the principal Ordinance and shall take effect as section 36A of that Ordinance :— Insertion of new section 36A in the principal Ordinance.
- 36A. Every debenture shall be inscribed with a certificate bearing the signature or the facsimile of the signature of the Financial Secretary in the form set out in Schedule D. Such certificate shall for all purposes be conclusive evidence of the fact that the debenture has been duly issued in conformity with the provisions of this Ordinance, and that the payment of the principal of the debenture and of the interest thereon is a charge upon the general revenue of the Island under section 38. Certificate of Financial Secretary to be conclusive proof of regularity of issue of debenture.

Insertion of new section 37A in the principal Ordinance.

Issue of debentures in the name of a minor.

5 The following new section shall be inserted immediately after section 37 of the principal Ordinance, and shall have effect as section 37A of that Ordinance :—

37A. (1) The Board may issue debentures in the name of a minor upon application in that behalf made by the minor, or by either of his parents or by the person to whom a certificate of curatorship to the estate of the minor has been granted.

(2) Where any application is made under sub-section (1) or where any debenture is issued upon such application, the provisions of this Chapter and of any rules made under section 91 (*d*) shall, save as otherwise provided in this section or in section 39A but notwithstanding anything in any written or other law to the contrary, apply in like manner as if such application was made by or on behalf of, or such debenture was issued in the name of, a person who has attained the age of twenty-one years.

Repeal of section 38A of the principal Ordinance.

6 Section 38A of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Insertion of new section 39A in the principal Ordinance.

Payments in respect of debentures issued in the name of a minor.

7 The following new section shall be inserted immediately after section 39 of the principal Ordinance, and shall have effect as section 39A of that Ordinance :—

39A. (1) The interest on and principal of any debenture issued in the name of a minor shall be paid—

- (a) if the debenture was issued upon the application of the minor, to the minor ;
- (b) if the debenture was issued upon the application of his parent or of a person to whom a certificate of curatorship to the estate of the minor has been granted, to the parent or to such person or to the successor of such person, as the case may be :

Provided, however, that—

- (i) where a debenture is issued in the name of a minor upon application made by his parent, the interest on and principal of the debenture may, if the parent so requires, be paid to the minor ; and
- (ii) every payment made in respect of any debenture issued in the name of any person who is not, on the date of payment, a minor, shall be made to that person.

(2) The receipt of any minor, parent or other person for any money paid to him in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) shall, notwithstanding anything in any written or other law to the contrary, be a full and sufficient discharge therefor.

Amendment of section 53 of the principal Ordinance.

8 Section 53 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the re-numbering of that section as sub-section (1) ;
- (b) in the re-numbered sub-section (1),—
 - (i) by the substitution in paragraph (*a*) thereof, for the words "The amount on loan" of the words "The total amount on loan" ; and
 - (ii) by the substitution for paragraph (*d*) thereof, of the following :—

" (*d*) The amount of any loan which may be granted by the Bank at any time on the security of any property, together with such amount, if any, as may at that time be outstanding in respect of any earlier loan on the security of the same property, shall not exceed one-half of the amount at which that property is valued at that time in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance."

- (c) by the addition after the re-numbered sub-section (1) of the following new sub-section which shall have effect as sub-section (2) of that section :—

" (2) Where a loan has been granted by the Bank and the property mortgaged as security for that loan is not encumbered by any mortgage to any person other than the Bank, the Bank

may, subject to the other provisions of this Ordinance relating to loans, grant an additional loan the repayment of which shall be secured by a further mortgage of that property; and such further mortgage shall, for the purposes of sub-section (1) and of section 4, be deemed to be a primary mortgage."

9 The provisions of section 53 of the principal Ordinance as amended by section 8 of this Ordinance shall have effect as if they were in force on the ninth day of June, 1933.

Retrospective effect of section 53 of the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

10 Section 64 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

Substitution of new section for section 64 of the principal Ordinance.

64. Besides the amount due on the loan, the Board may recover from the debtor or any person acting on his behalf—

Recovery of expenses and costs incurred by the Bank.

(a) all moneys expended by the Bank, in accordance with the covenants contained in the mortgage bond executed by the debtor, in the payment of premiums and other charges in respect of the policy of insurance effected on the land mortgaged to the Bank and in the payment of all other costs and charges authorised to be incurred by the Bank, under the covenants contained in the mortgage bond executed by the debtor; and

(b) the costs of advertising the sale and of selling the land: Provided that the costs incurred under this paragraph shall not exceed such percentage of the loan as may be prescribed.

11 Section 65 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "costs payable" occurring in that section, of the words "moneys and costs recoverable".

Amendment of section 65 of the principal Ordinance.

12 (1) The following new section shall be inserted immediately after section 83 of the principal Ordinance, and shall have effect as section 83A of that Ordinance:—

Insertion of new section 83A in the principal Ordinance.

83A. (1) The Governor may from time to time at the request of the Board authorise the Deputy Financial Secretary to lend to the Bank, for periods not exceeding one year out of the general revenue of the Island, such sums as the Governor may deem necessary, upon such terms as may be determined by the Financial Secretary as to the mode and time of repayment of any sum so lent and of the interest payable thereon.

Governor's power to authorise loans to the Bank out of general revenue.

(2) The provisions of sub-section (1) shall be in addition to and not in substitution of the provisions of section 83, and no report under section 82 shall be necessary in order to enable the Governor to exercise the powers conferred by that sub-section.

(2) The new section 83A inserted in the principal Ordinance by sub-section (1) shall be deemed to have had effect on and after the thirty-first day of October, 1936.

13 The following new Schedule shall be added immediately after Schedule C to the principal Ordinance and shall have effect as Schedule D to that Ordinance:—

Insertion of new Schedule D to the principal Ordinance.

SCHEDULE D.

(Section 36a.)

Form of Certificate.

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Dog Registration Amendment Ordinance, No. 26 of 1938.

Amendment of section 5 of Ordinance No. 25 of 1901.

2 Section 5 of the Dog Registration Ordinance, 1901, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended as follows:—

- (1) by the substitution for the words "one rupee and fifty cents" of the words "five rupees"; and
- (2) by the substitution, for all the words from "Provided further" to the end of the section, of the words "Provided further that within the limits of the Colombo Municipality the proper authority may charge an annual registration fee not exceeding seven rupees and fifty cents in the case of female dogs".

Amendment of section 14 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 14 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for all the words from "the said Board," to the end of the section of the words "the said Board."

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof.

No. 27 of 1938.

An Ordinance to prevent the treatment of venereal disease otherwise than by registered medical practitioners or specially authorised practitioners of indigenous medicine, and to control the supply of remedies therefor, and for other matters connected therewith.

A. CALDECOTT.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Venereal Disease Ordinance, No. 27 of 1938.

Prevention of treatment of venereal disease otherwise than by duly qualified or specially authorised persons.

2 (1) In any part of Ceylon to which the provisions of this section apply, no person other than—

- (a) a registered medical practitioner; or
- (b) a practitioner of indigenous medicine who has been specially thereto authorised in writing by the Governor with the advice of the Executive Committee,

shall, for reward either direct or indirect, treat any person for venereal disease or prescribe any remedy therefor or give any advice in connection with the treatment thereof, whether the advice is given to the person treated or to any other person.

(2) The Governor may, with the advice of the Executive Committee, by Proclamation published in the Gazette, direct that the provisions of this section shall apply to the whole or any specified part of Ceylon.

3 (1) No person shall by advertisement or any public notice or announcement treat or offer to treat any person for venereal disease, or prescribe or offer to prescribe any remedy therefor, or offer to give or give any advice in connection with the treatment thereof.

Restriction on advertisements, &c.

(2) No person shall hold out or recommend to the public by any notice or advertisement, or by any written or printed papers or handbills, or by any label or words written or printed affixed to or delivered with, any packet, box, bottle, phial, or other inclosure containing the same, any pills, capsules, powders, lozenges, tinctures, potions, cordials, electuaries, plaisters, unguents, salves, ointments, drops, lotions, oils, spirits, medicated herbs and waters, chemical and official preparations whatsoever, to be used or applied externally or internally as medicines or medicaments for the prevention, cure, or relief of any venereal disease :

Provided that nothing in this section shall apply to any advertisement, notification, announcement, recommendation, or holding out made or published by any person with the sanction in writing of the Executive Committee, or to any publication sent only to registered medical practitioners or to wholesale or retail chemists for the purposes of their business.

4 Any person who does any act in contravention of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees or to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Penalties.

5 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

“ Executive Committee ” means the Executive Committee of Health ;

“ indigenous medicine ” includes the systems of medicine known as Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani ;

“ registered medical practitioner ” means a person registered as a medical practitioner under the Medical Ordinance, 1927 ;

No. 26 of 1927.

“ venereal disease ” means syphilis, gonorrhoea or soft chancre and includes any complication of any such disease.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Officers' Security Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1938.

Short title.

2 Section 2 of the Public Officers' Security Ordinance, 1890, (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Ordinance ”), is hereby amended in sub-section (1) (a) thereof by the substitution, for the words “ and the making of periodical payments ”, of the words “ and by the deposit of moneys or the making of periodical payments ”.

Amendment of section 2 of Ordinance No. 14 of 1890.

3 Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution, for the words “ periodical payments ”, of the words “ deposits or periodical payments ”.

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Ordinance.

Insertion of new section 11, in the principal Ordinance.

Rules relating to personal bond and deposit of moneys or periodical payments.

4 The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 10, and shall have effect as section 11 of the principal Ordinance :—

11. (1) In respect of the way or method, referred to in section 2 of giving security by personal bond and by the deposit of moneys or the making of periodical payments in accordance with the terms of such bond, the Governor may make rules, applicable to all departments of the public service generally or to any specified department or to any specified public officer or class of public officers, for all or any of the following purposes :—

- (a) for prescribing the amount of the security to be given ;
- (b) for prescribing the form and the mode of execution and attestation of the personal bond, and the authority or officer to whom the bond is to be delivered for safe keeping ;
- (c) for prescribing the amount of the initial deposit or payment, the rates and the intervals at which further deposits or periodical payments are to be made, the manner in which and the authority or officer with or to whom such deposits or payments are to be made, and the manner in which the receipt of such deposits or payments is to be acknowledged, and the accounts thereof are to be kept, by such authority or officer ;
- (d) for authorising the crediting of interest on the aggregate amount of the deposits or payments standing to the credit of each officer, until the full amount of the prescribed security is deposited or paid by him; and the payment to such officer of the interest accruing thereafter ; and for prescribing, in any case where no express provision is made by any other written law, the mode of determining the rate and the intervals at which such interest is to be credited or paid, and the form of the interest certificate to be issued to each officer ;
- (e) for authorising, in the case of any department of the public service in respect of which no express provision is made by any other written law, the formation of a Fund to which the deposits or periodical payments made by the officers of that department may be credited ; for providing for the administration of such Fund ; and for prescribing the form or nature of the accounts to be kept in connection therewith and the intervals at which such accounts are to be audited ;
- (f) for prescribing the securities in which, and the conditions subject to which, the whole or any part of any Fund formed under the authority of any rule made under this section, or, where no such Fund has been formed, the whole or any part of the deposits or payments made by the officers, may be invested ;
- (g) for prescribing the circumstances and the manner in which the whole or any part of the deposits or payments and interest standing to the credit of any officer may be appropriated by order of the head of the department to which the officer belongs, in order to meet any loss incurred by the Crown by reason of any default or omission or any dishonest or negligent act on the part of the officer ;
- (h) for prescribing the circumstances in which the whole or any part of the deposits or payments and interest standing to the credit of any officer may be declared forfeit to the Crown ;
- (i) for prescribing the terms and conditions on which a public officer may be permitted to withdraw the amount of the deposits or payments and interest standing to his credit after his retirement, resignation or dismissal from office ;
- (j) for suspending or modifying the application of such of the provisions of sections 3 to 10, inclusive, as may relate to any of the purposes for which rules are made under this section ; and
- (k) generally for all purposes incidental to or connected with the purposes specifically mentioned in this sub-section.

(2) Every rule made by the Governor under this section shall be published in the Gazette and shall come into operation upon the date of such publication.

5 The amendments made in the principal Ordinance by sections 2 and 3 shall be deemed for all purposes to have come into operation on the date on which the principal Ordinance came into operation.

Retrospective operation of sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

Although the security required from the officers of the Post and Telegraph Department for the due performance of their duties had from 1886 been given by them in instalments paid at stated intervals or deducted monthly from their salaries, the Public Officers' Security Ordinance which was passed four years later did not recognise this system, which thus remained unauthorised by law until the Post Office Security Fund Ordinance was passed in 1931. The latter Ordinance, however, was primarily meant to provide for the management and use of the moneys collected by way of security from the officers; and although it contains a Schedule of regulations as to the system of giving security to be followed in the Post and Telegraph Department, it does not deal with the subject comprehensively, nor does it exclude the officers of the Department from the operation of the Ordinance of 1890, which was intended to apply to all public officers. In order to regularise the position the Public Officers' Security Amendment Ordinance, No. 15 of 1935, amended the Ordinance of 1890 by including in it a reference to the system of furnishing security adopted by the Post and Telegraph Department; but as the method of working the system is not laid down in detail in that Ordinance and has still to be sought for in the Post Office Security Fund Ordinance, some difficulty has been experienced in actual practice in applying two different sets of provisions simultaneously. A further problem has now been created by the discovery that the officers of the Railway and the Public Works Departments have for many years followed a similar extra-legal method of giving security and that in their case too this method has to be authorised by law. It has therefore been decided that the Public Officers' Security Ordinance, 1890, should be further amended by the addition of a new section enabling the Governor to make rules of procedure, applicable to all Departments of the public service generally or to any specified Department, for the purpose of prescribing the details of this method of giving security and the manner in which the fund created out of the cash security collected by each Department should be administered. The proposed section is set out in Clause 4 of this Bill, some preliminary amendments necessary in sections 2 and 3 of the Ordinance being first dealt with in Clauses 2 and 3.

2. Those parts of the Post Office Security Fund Ordinance, 1931, which now make provision for the same matters are to be repealed at the same time. For this purpose a separate Bill to amend that Ordinance will be introduced as a complementary measure immediately after this Bill.
