The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Small Towns Sanitary Ordinance, 1892.

No. 18 of 1892.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Small Towns Sanitary (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1938.

Amendment of section 9F of Ordinance No. 18 of 1892.

2 The Small Towns Sanitary Ordinance, 1892, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended in section 9F by the addition, at the end thereof, of the following :—

" Provided further that in sanctioning the conditions for the repayment of the said loan, the Governor may dispense with the requirements provided for in section 9I."

Amendment of section 9I of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 9I of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended, by the addition at the end thereof, of the following :—

" Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply where an order has been made by the Governor under the last proviso to section 9F dispensing with the requirements provided for in this section."

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Small Towns Sanitary Ordinance, 1892, in order to enable the Governor, in sanctioning the conditions for the repayment of loans made by the Ceylon Government to any Sanitary Board, to provide for the total extinction of the debt on payment by the Board of fixed instalments for a definite number of years. As, in such cases, the sinking fund required by section 9I of the Ordinance will not be necessary, it is proposed to add a proviso to section 9F to the effect that the requirements of section 9I may in such cases be dispensed with, and a proviso with the like effect to section 9I of the Ordinance.
