KNOW Ye that in pursuance of the provisions of Article 74 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I, Guy Stanley Wodeman, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation signify the assent given by His Majesty the King, through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, to the Bill intituled "An Ordinance further to amend the Courts Ordinance, 1889", which was passed by the State Council on the Ninth day of February, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-eight, and was reserved by the Governor under Article 77 of the aforesaid Order in Council for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure.

Given at Colombo, in the Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-fourth day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-eight.
