MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Colombo Graving Dock and Patent Slip Ordinance, 1908.

No. 5 of 1908.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Graving Dock and Patent Slip (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 193 .

Short title.

2 Section 2 of the Colombo Graving Dock and Patent Slip Ordinance, 1908, is hereby amended in the definition of "Graving dock" in that section by the substitution, for the words "graving dock" where those words occur collectively for the second and third times in that definition, of the words "graving docks".

Amendment of section 2 of Ordinance No. 5 of 1908.

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to amend the definition or "graving dock" in the Colombo Graving Dock and Patent Slip Ordinance, 1908, so as to make the provisions of that Ordinance applicable to the new Inner Graving Dock which was recently constructed.
