An Ordinance to amend the Vagrants Ordinance.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Vagrants Amendment Ordinance, No. of 1939.

Amendment of
section 24 of
Chapter 26.

2 Section 24 of the Vagrants Ordinance (Chapter 26) is hereby amended in sub-section (1) thereof by the substitution for paragraph (b), of the following new paragraph:—

“(b) any police officer not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector; or”.

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Vagrants Ordinance (Chapter 26) so as to enable the police to deal more effectively with the tout nuisance which is adversely affecting the tourist industry in Ceylon.

2. Under section 24 (1) (b) of the Ordinance, a sworn statement made by a person about to leave the Island may be given in evidence against the person accused on any charge under section 3 (1) (e), if such statement is made before the officer for the time being in charge of a police station, not being below the rank of a Sub-Inspector.

3. Most passengers are reluctant, on the ground of inconvenience, to proceed to a police station for the purpose of making complaints before an officer in charge of a station. It is therefore proposed to amend the law to enable statements of passengers to be made before any police officer not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector.

It is further ordered that the 1st respondent above named be and she is hereby appointed guardian *ad litem* of the minors, the 2nd and 3rd respondents, unless the respondents above named or any other person or persons interested shall, on or before April 13, 1939, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
