THE RABIES ORDINANCE.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (2) of section 14 of the Rabies Ordinance (Chapter 333), I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, hereby notify that all licences issued in respect of the class of dogs specified in the schedule hereto shall be exempted from the requirements of that sub-section.

SCHEDULE.

All dogs registered at the Customs Office prior to exportation or identified by such other proof as the Principal Collector of Customs may deem adequate and proved to his satisfaction to have been exhibited at any Show held under licence issued by the Kennel Club of India and to have been reimported into Ceylon within seven days after the conclusion of such Show.
