

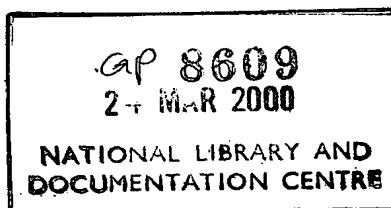

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- Publishing text of an Order in Council dated September 2, 1939, which sets out in a schedule thereto the Prize Courts Rules, 1939, supplement to No. 8,526
- Appointing under Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6) Matara, in the Southern Circuit as the place at which the criminal sessions of the Supreme Court for that circuit, and fixing November 6, 1939, as the date of commencement, 1830
- Confirming under Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173) the declaration of the "diseased locality" made by the Government Agent, Eastern Province, and published in *Supplement to Gazette* of August 28, 1925, 1830
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- Notifying under Air Navigation (Colonies, Protectorates and Mandated Territories) Order, 1927, that the Director of Civil Aviation has authorized the Aerodrome Officer and Additional Aerodrome Officer to exercise the power to prevent the flight of aircraft, 1882
- Making under Defence (Control of Exports) Regulations certain appointments for the purposes of the aforesaid regulations, 1915
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- Order under Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations directing that, except under authority of a licence granted by the Controller of Imports, the goods specified in schedule shall not be imported into Ceylon from any territory or place, and exempting certain goods from such restrictions, 1919
- Authorizing under Local Government (Pensions and Gratuities) Ordinance No. 74 of 1938, the Panadura Urban District Council to declare that any by-law made by that Council for the provision of pensions and gratuities to the widows, &c., of deceased officers shall be applicable to the case of any officer or servant, who has died while in service of the Council and on a date not earlier than the 1st day of January, 1933, 1924
- Directing under Vehicles Ordinance (Chapter 155) that the stamp to be affixed on the counterfoil of a licence in respect of a hand-cart with the administrative limits of Panadura Urban District Council shall be Re. 1, 1924
- cart drawn by two bullocks within the administrative limits of the Municipal Council of Galle shall be Rs. 4, and a cart drawn by one bullock Rs. 2, and rescinding notification published in *Gazette* of December 22, 1916, relating to the above, 2255

- Approving under Criminal Procedure Code (Chapter 16) the institutions mentioned in schedule to be "approved homes", 1966
