IN the Name of His Majesty GEORGE VI by the Grace of God of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ANDREW CALDECOTT, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Territories and Dependencies thereof.

KNOW Ye that in pursuance of the provisions of Article 74 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation signify the assent given by His Majesty the King, through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, to the Bill intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the regulation and control of the prices of commodities", which was passed by the State Council on the Nineteenth day of July, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-nine, and was reserved by me under Article 77 of the aforesaid Order in Council for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure.

Given at Colombo, in the Island of Ceylon, this First day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-nine.
