By His Excellency Sir ANDREW CALDECOTT, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Territories and Dependencies thereof.

KNOW Ye that I, Andrew Caldecott, the Governor and Vice-Admiral of Ceylon, being satisfied by information received from a Secretary of State, do hereby proclaim that war has broken out between His Majesty and the foreign state of Germany.

Given at Colombo this third day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-nine.
