THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (a) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the transport or removal from the Chief Headman's Division of Demala hatpattu, and the Korale's Division of Rajakumara Wanni pattu in Puttalam pattu, of paddy and kurakkan grown in the said Divisions or of rice made from such paddy, except under the authority of a permit issued by the Deputy Food Controller for the Puttalam-Chilaw Districts.
