THE DEFENCE (CENSORSHIP) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Governor in pursuance of the provisions of regulation 2 of the Defence (Censorship) Regulations.

ORDER.

No person shall convey from Ceylon to any destination outside Ceylon, or convey into Ceylon, otherwise than by post, any document, pictorial representation, photograph, chart, map, sketch, plan, technical publication or other article whatsoever which—

- (1) contains or is likely to disclose information with respect to the movement, numbers, description, condition or disposition of any of the Forces, ships or aircraft of His Majesty, or with respect to the plans or conduct or supposed plans or conduct of any operations by any such Forces, ships or aircraft, or with respect to the supply, description, condition, transport, manufacture or storage or place or intended place of manufacture or storage of war material, or with respect to any works or measures undertaken for or connected with or intended for the fortification or defence of any place, or any information of such a pattern that it is calculated to be or is capable of being, directly or indirectly, useful to the approximation of such as a contract of the contract of
- a nature that it is calculated to be, or is capable of being, directly or indirectly, useful to the enemy;

  (2) contains any statement of fact or opinion which is likely to be prejudicial to the public safety and tranquillity, or to interfere with the success of His Majesty's Forces by land, sea or air, or to prejudice His Majesty's relations with any foreign power, or to cause or spread any disaffection among any of His Majesty's subjects, or to interfere with the production or purchaso of materials necessary for the efficient prosecution of the war or the maintenance of supplies and services essential to the life of the community; or
- (3) contains any reference to contraband of war, or goods which are of enemy origin or are destined for an enemy or enemy country.
