An Ordinance to amend the Food Control Ordinance.

A. CALDECOTT.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Food Control (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 42 of 1939.

Short title.

2 Section 6 of the Food Control Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

Amendment of
section 6 of
Chapter 132.

(1) in sub-section (2) (c) (i) by the substitution for all the words from “supply the number or quantity” to “of his business; or”, of the words “supply the number or quantity demanded; or”; and

(2) by the addition of the following new sub-section which shall have effect as sub-section (3) of that section :—

Cap. 16.

(3) Notwithstanding anything in the First Schedule to the Criminal Procedure Code, every offence under this Ordinance shall be a cognizable offence within the meaning of that Code.
