An Ordinance to amend the Essential Commodities Reserves Ordinance, No. 5 of 1939.

A. CALDECOTT.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

- Short title. **1** This Ordinance may be cited as the Essential Commodities Reserves (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 46 of 1939.
- Amendment of Ordinance No. 5 of 1939. **2** The Essential Commodities Reserves Ordinance, No. 5 of 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinance"), is hereby amended by the substitution, for the word "Director", wherever that word occurs in any section of the principal Ordinance other than section 17, of the word "Controller".
- Amendment of section 17 of the principal Ordinance. **3** Section 17 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution, for the definition of "Director", of the following definition:—
 "Controller" means the person for the time being appointed to be or to act as Food Controller for the purposes of the Food Control Ordinance (*Chapter 132*);
