### Notification of Land Kachcheri to select Persons to receive Permits—(Middle-Class Ceylonese).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Assistant Government Agent, Vavuniya, will hold a Land Kachcheri under the Land Development Ordinance, No. 19 of 1935, at 9 A.M. on Thursday, February 8, 1940, at the Vavuniya Kachcheri, to consider applications for the lands, particulars of which are given below, and to select persons to receive permits for portions thereof.

2. Allotments will be confined to Middle-Class Ceylonese.

3. All applications must reach the Assistant Government Agent at the Vavuniya Kachcheri on or before January 16, 1940.

4. All applications must be accompanied by a deposit of Rs. 3 per acre of the extent applied for. The deposit will not be refunded if owing to any act or omission of the applicant Government is put to the expense of an unnecessary survey.
