**THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.**

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.**

DEFENCE regulation made by the Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified, and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939.

**REGULATION.**

The Schedule to the Defence (Finance) Regulations published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,509 of September 19, 1939, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (1) in item 1 of that Schedule, by the substitution, for the words "Any territory", of the words "Any territory, other than Egypt and Iraq"; and
- (2) by the omission from that Schedule of item 6—Sudan.

**THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.**

IT is hereby notified in terms of section 4 (4) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), that the Board of Ministers has refused to confirm the Order made under section 4 (1) (a) of the Ordinance and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,540 of October 31, 1939, prohibiting the transport or removal from the Nuwarakalawiya division of the North-Central Province, of paddy grown in the said division, or of rice made from such paddy, except under the authority of a permit issued by the Deputy Food Controller of the said Province.
