It is ordered that the petitioner be and he is hereby declared entitled, as the eldest son of the above-named deceased, to have letters of administration to his estate issued to him, and that the 6th respondent above named be and he is hereby appointed guardian *ad litem* over the 2nd to 5th minors, respondents, unless the respondents above named or any other person or persons interested shall, on or before December 4, 1940, show sufficient cause to the contrary to the satisfaction of this court.
