THE TRINCOMALEE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1941.

 $Notification\ of\ Appointment\ of\ King's\ Harbour\ Master.$

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 2 of the Trincomalee Defence Regulations, 1941, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do hereby declare that Commander George Elliott Harden, D.S.O., Royal Navy (Retired), has been appointed by the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty as King's Harbour Master for the Port of Trincomalee with effect from February 14, 1941.
