GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Regulation 37 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 8,533 of October 20, 1939, as amended by the Regulation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,639 of July 20, 1940, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order—

- (1) direct that the entire stock of asbestos cement corrugated sheeting belonging to, or in the possession or under the control of, the company trading in Ceylon under the name and style of Brown & Co., Limited, shall be requisitioned by James William Warby, Government Storekeeper;
- (2) direct that no person who on the seventeenth day of March, 1941 (being the date on which this Order takes effect) has in his possession or under his control at any premises in Ceylon any of the asbestos cement corrugated sheeting described in paragraph (1) of this Order, shall remove such asbestos cement corrugated sheeting or any part thereof or cause or permit such sheeting or part thereof to be removed from such premises except under the authority of a permit issued under the hand of the aforesaid James William Warby;
- (3) require the occupier of any premises in Ceylon in which the asbestos cement corrugated sheeting described in paragraph (1) or any part of such asbestos cement corrugated sheeting is kept or stored to send to the aforesaid James William Warby a written declaration stating whether or not, on the said seventeenth day of March, 1941, any such asbestos cement corrugated sheeting or part thereof was on such premises, and, if so, the quantity of such asbestos cement corrugated sheeting which was on such premises on that date;
- (4) authorize the aforesaid James William Warby or any other person acting under his directions to do all such acts or things, and, if need be, to use all such force, as may be necessary to give effect to the preceding provisions of this Order; and
- (5) authorize and require all police officers to aid and assist the aforesaid James William Warby in the exercise of his powers and in the discharge of his duties under the preceding provisions of this Order.
