LAND SETTLEMENT ORDINANCE.

Settlement Order.

Confirmation of the Mapping-out of Helayakumbura Village.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Land Commissioner has confirmed, under section 14 of the Land Development Ordinance, No. 19 of 1935, a scheme of mapping-out and diagram depicting the mapped-out areas for the Helayakumbura village, in the Dambawinipalata korale of Udakunda division, Badulla District (F. V. P. 188)
