THE DEFENCE (PROHIBITION OF EXPORTS) REGULATIONS.

Order.

IN pursuance of the provisions of regulation 3 of the Defence (Prohibition of Exports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order—

(1) substitute in the First Schedule of those Regulations, for the words "Empty Bottles" in item 3 thereof, the following :—
"Empty bottles, other than bottles which are intended to serve as samples for the guidance of manufacturers or suppliers and are sent in such quantities as the Principal Collector of Customs may consider reasonable in each case.";

(2) add to the aforesaid First Schedule the following new item :—

"(5) Metalliferous ores and scrap metal of every description, other than the ores or metal referred to in the Second Schedule."; and

(3) substitute in the Second Schedule to those Regulations, for the item "Metalliferous ores and scrap metal of every description", the following :—

"Such metalliferous ores and scrap metal of any description as it may, in the opinion of the Principal Collector of Customs, be necessary to export to any territory forming part of the British Empire, for the purposes of the execution of any contract which is proved to his satisfaction to have been entered into with any person in that territory before the first day of April, 1941."
