THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE.

Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent of the Western Province, the proper authority in that behalf, on June 6, 1941

The whole of Peliyagoda Peruwa in Ragam pattu of Alutkuru korale south, Colombo District, bounded on the—
North by the villages Mattumagala and Mahabage,
West by Kelani-ganga and Old Canal;

East by the villages Peliyagoda, Wedamulla Wanawahala, Hunupitiya, and Gongitota.
