MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :---

L. D.---O 44/40---B 1808

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance. BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows :---

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1941.

2. The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 101 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance and shall have effect as section 101A of that Ordinance :-

101A. The authority for expenditure conveyed by any budget or supplemental budget passed by the Council shall expire at the end of the financial year to which such budget relates.

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to insert in the Municipal Councils Ordinance express provision to the effect that no expenditure can be incurred under the authority of the budget or any supplemental budget of a Municipal Council at any time after the end of the financial year to which the budget relates.
