THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE.

Order under Section 2

I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance, do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of the 9th/10th day of July, 1941, to demand and levy on the goods severally specified in Column I of the schedule hereto, export duty at the rates prescribed in the corresponding entries in Column II of that schedule

Provided that nothing herein contained shall affect any export duty on tea, rubber or rubber latex leviable or payable under any written law other than the Customs Ordinance and the Medical Wants Ordinance.
