THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE.

Notification

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the " diseased locality " specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, the proper authority in that behalf, on July 16, 1941.

SCHEDULE.

The area bounded as follows.—

- North A line drawn parallel with the Ratnapura-Wewelwatta P. W. D. road from a point 100 yards due north of culvert No. 64/5 on that road to a point 100 yards due north of culvert No. 67/10 on that road.
East From the last mentioned point, a line running due south to the Bambarabotuwa-oya.
South Bambarabotuwa-oya and Denawak-ganga
West From the starting point of the Northern boundary, a line running due south to the Denawak-ganga.
