THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940

DEFENCE Regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940

REGULATION.

The Defence (Finance) Regulations, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No 8,509 of September 19, 1939, as last amended by the regulation published in *Gazette* No 8,733 of April 3, 1941, are hereby further amended as follows —

(1) in regulation 4A—

(a) by the substitution, for all the words from "Where the Governor" to "British Empire," of the following —

'Where the Governor is satisfied, upon information received from the Secretary of State, that owing to the changes in the external or internal position of any State, action is being, or is likely to be, taken to the detriment of the economic position of the British Empire or otherwise to the prejudice of the efficient prosecution of the war,'

(b) by the substitution, in paragraph (a) of that regulation, for the words "the first-mentioned State", of the words "that State";

(2) in regulation 6—

(a) by the substitution, in paragraph (3) (a) of that regulation, for the words "under paragraph (6)", of the words "under paragraph (3)", and

(b) by the substitution, in paragraph (3) (b) of that regulation, for the words "under paragraph (8)", of the words "under paragraph (4) or paragraph (6)".
