The Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

Order under Regulation 33.

I, William Oswald Stevens, Government Agent of the Southern Province, being a competent authority within that Province for the purposes of regulation 33 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations by virtue of the appointment notified in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,562 of December 28, 1939, do, in the exercise of the powers conferred on a competent authority by paragraph (2) of that regulation, by this Order direct that no person shall cut or attempt to cut the sand-bar at the seaward end of the water channel between the Koggala lagoon and the sea except under the authority and in accordance with the conditions of a written permit issued by the Government Agent of the Southern Province.

2. The Order under Regulation 33 (2) of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, published at page 663 of *Gazette* No. 8,748 of May 23, 1941, is hereby rescinded.
