THE PETROL (CONTROL OF SUPPLIES) ORDINANCE, No 52 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Petrol (Control of Supplies) Ordinance, No. 52 of 1939, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this order fix the first day of November, 1941, as the date on and after which no person other than a vendor shall purchase or obtain any petrol—

a) unless he is an approved consumer and is the holder of a permit issued by the Controller under this Ordinance; or b) unless an order authorising the sale or supply of a specified quantity of petrol to him by a supplier has been issued by the
