SANATOGEN.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices, do by this order—

- (i) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per bottle above which Sanatogen of the description specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule and of the net contents specified in column 2 of the Schedule shall not be sold by retail in any part of Ceylon,
- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order any sale of any quantity of Sanatogen for the purpose of consumption shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (iii) direct that any trader who, at any premises, exposes for sale any Sanatogen of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of such Sanatogen, and
- (iv) direct that any trader who sells any Sanatogen of the description specified in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of such Sanatogen a receipt on which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,
 - (b) the quantity sold,
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold, and
 - (d) the description of Sanatogen sold
