Irrigation Rules passed by the Village Committees of the District of Seven Korales under Ordinance No. 23 of 1889.

1. No proprietor or other person shall be at liberty to do any act in his own interest calculated to affect injuriously any privilege or right which other proprietors are entitled to enjoy in common with him.
2. A pangakarāya who has failed to perform the work due by him on tank or channel, besides being liable to a fine, shall not be entitled to water until he has performed his task.
3. No one shall cultivate the bed of a tank without the permission of the Chief Irrigation Headman (i.e., the Ratémahatmayá). Appeal shall lie to the Government Agent.

3. දිය රෙගුලාසිය යටතේ සත්වූ ප්‍රධාන මුලාදානියාගේ එකම රථවලක්මයාගේ අවසර නැතුව වැවු කාවල්ලක් වැඩකරන්නට බැරිය. ඉහතකී මූලාදානියාගේ තීන්දුවට එකඟභූත කෙනෙකුට ආණ්ඩුවේ ඒජන්ත ලියකාන්සේට ඇපාල්ගත්තට පුළුවන.
