MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, June 14, 1895, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 p.m., pursuant to notice dated June 8, 1895.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Acting Mayor and Chairman; Captain F. Bayley; Dr. J. L. Vanderstraaten; Mr. E. Creasy; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alwis.

The Minutes of May 10 and 21, 1895, having been printed and a copy having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of May 10 and 21, 1895, be confirmed.

1. The consideration of the following motion standing in Hon. P. Coomaraswamy's name was deferred, in consequence of Mr. Coomaraswamy's absence:—"To move for a return giving the names of the Members of the Council for each year from 1865 to 1895."

2. A statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to May 31, 1895, was laid on the table. The Progress Report of Work done during May, 1895, was not ready to be submitted in consequence of illness among the clerical staff.

3. Letters No. 53 of May 21, 1895, and No. 65 of June 5, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, relating to the proposed extension of Municipal limits, were laid before the Council, with connected papers.

Resolved,—That the question be deferred pending a reply from Government to the Chairman's letter No. 107 of June 12, 1895.

4. A letter No. 61 of May 30, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, relating to the conversion of the kachcheri grass garden into a general recreation ground, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Council, while thanking Government for the offer, do ascertain whether Government will sanction the expenditure of the sum of Rs. 9,070 on drainage in the first instance, in the manner indicated in the Superintendent of Works' letter No. 394 of June 12, 1895.

Resolved further,—That the Government be asked to furnish this Council with the estimate prepared by the Director of Public Works.

5. Letters No. 45 of May 9, No. 62 of June 1, and No. 71/07427 of June 10, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the erection of a gun-shed in the Racket Court for Artillery Volunteers, were laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Council has no objection to offer to the erection of a gun-shed for Artillery Volunteers in the corner of the Racket Court opposite the old Sailors' Home.

6. A letter No. 69 of June 6, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, in reply to the application made upon a resolution of Council of April 5, 1895, for certain returns relating to water, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That inquiry be made as to whether the quantity of water supplied to Government buildings is included under the head "For the gratuitous use of the inhabitants of the Municipality for domestic purposes" in the return furnished by the Director of Public Works.

Mr. C. M. Fernando moved "that the estimate referred to in the 2nd paragraph of the Director's letter No. 1,234 of May 2/6, 1895, appended to the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 69, be called for.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

7. Letters dated May 10 and 17, 1895, from Mr. E. D. Mathews on the Colombo tramways, together with a memorandum thereon, dated May 31, from the Chairman, were laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. Mathews' application for a further extension of time be declined."

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

A letter dated June 13, 1895, was read from Messrs. Boustead Brothers, inquiring whether an application from them for a concession to construct tramways would receive consideration in the event of the present arrangements not being carried out.

Resolved,—That Messrs. Boustead Brothers be informed that the Council will be prepared to consider their application.

8. The Auditor-General's remarks for January, 1895, received with letter No. 31 of May 15, 1895, were laid on the table.

9. Further remarks by the Auditor-General on the accounts for February, 1893, and January, 1895, were laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the expenditure of Rs. 9.50, surcharged by the Auditor-General in the accounts of February, 1893, be sanctioned.

Resolved further,—That the remark on the surcharge of Rs. 9.45 in the accounts of January, 1895, on account of the pension of the Superintendent, Slaughter-house, be referred to the Standing Committee.

10. The City Analyst's report dated May 31, on the town water for May, 1895, having been previously printed and circulated, was laid on the table.

11. A notification dated June 6, 1895, from the Chairman was read, to the effect that Sir J. J. Grinlinton having been absent for three consecutive General Meetings had vacated his seat as a Member of Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Sir J. J. Grinlinton be restored to office in accordance with clause 32 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887.

Mr. C. P. Dias seconded.—Carried.

12. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for June, 1895, were laid on the table.
