THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940. DEFENCE Regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the Devenue of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940

Regulation.

The Defence Force (Compulsory Leave) Regulation published in Gazette No. 8,516 of September 28, 1939, as amended by the Regulation published in Gazette No 8,642 of July 26, 1940, is hereby further amended—

(1) by the insertion immediately after paragraph (3a) of that Regulation of the following new paragraph --

" (3B) (i) Where any member of a Defence Force Corps who has been placed on compulsory leave as

hereinbefore provided is appointed under section 25 of the Pohce Ordinance to act as a special police officer, that member shall, while so acting, be exempt from the duty to attend every such drill, parade, practice or other exercise as is referred to in paragraph (́3⊾)

(11) Every member of the reserve of any Defence Force Corps who is appointed under section 25 of the Police Orlya who is appointed index section 25 of the Police Ordinance to act as a special police officer shall, while so acting, be exempt from the obligation to undergo such training as may be prescribed by or under the Defence Force Ordinance.

(m) Nothing in sub-paragraph (i.) of this paragraph shall affect or be deemed or construed to affect the provisions of paragraph (3) of this Regulation; and nothing in sub-paragraph (n.) shall affect or be deemed or construed to affect the right of the Governor under the Defence Force Ordinance to call in for service any member of the reserve of early Defence Force any member of the reserve of any Defence Force Corps";

(2) by the substitution in paragraph (5) for the words "the Defence Force Ordinance" of the words "any written law other than this regulation".

THE CONTROL OF PRICES OBDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Regimed Sydney Vernon Pouher, Controller of Prices, do by this Order-

- (1.) rescend my Order dated December 12, 1941, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette No. 8,827 of December 12, 1941, m so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of rice of the description named and specified in column 1 of

N. 4149-1,127 (12/41) Municipal area, the maximum retail price per bushel within the Colombo Municipal area and the maximum retail price per measure within the Colombo Municipal area above which rice of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule horeto shall not be sold within the areas specified, provided that for any retail sale within the "Granaries" the maximum price per bag or bushel shall not exceed the maximum wholesale price at the "Granaries" per bag or per bushel (as the case may be) fixed by this Order; /
(iii.) direct that when rice of any description or grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule is sold by the bag (by wholesale or by retail) the maximum price fixed by this Order shall include the cost of the container in which such rice is sold;
(iv.) direct that when rice of any description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule is sold by the bushel (by wholesale or by retail) in quantities exceeding 2 bushels, the maximum price fixed by this Order shall include the price of the container in which such rice is sold;
(iv.) direct that every trader who, at any premises within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, exposes for sale rice of any description and grade specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto is sold by the price of any description and grade specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto is sold as the price of the container in which such rice is sold;
(v.) direct that every trader who, at any premises within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, exposes for sale rice of any description and grade specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto is and grade specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of rice of that description and grade ; Municipal area, the maximum retail price per bushel within the Colombo Municipal area and the maximum retail price

(v1.) direct that no trader shall sell any rice of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article or with rice of an inferior description and grade or quality;
(v1.) direct that every trader who sells rice of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give to the purchaser of that rice a receipt on which there shall be set out---

- - (1) the quantity, description and grade of rice sold ;

(1) the quantity, does prove the quantity of rice sold;
(2) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold;
(3) the date of sale;

- (4) the nature of the sale, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail, and
- (viii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order-

- (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 (b) any sale of any quantity of noe for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 (c) a bag of rice other than Broken Raw Rice shall contain not less than 77 measures by volume and 154 pounds of rice
- by weight;
- (d) a bag of Broken Raw Race shall contain not less than 115 measures by volume and 239 lb. of rice by weight; (e) the "Granaries" shall mean the "Chalmers' Granaries" and the "Manning Market" in the town of Colombo; and (f) measures shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure, equivalent to one thirty-second part of a bushel.

 - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to 1/32nd part of a bushel.
- (8) direct that every trader who sells any article mentioned in the First Schedule bereto shall give to the purchaser of that article on demand a receipt on which there shall be set out :-
 - (a) the description and grade of article sold,
 - the quantity of the article sold, the date of the sale,

 - the price paid for the article sold, and

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, John Radley Walters, Deputy Controller of Prices, Badulla District, do, by this Order :---

- (i.) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum wholesale price per bag.
 at the Granaries, Colombo, above which rice of any description and grade shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column II. of the Second Schedule hereto, as the maximum retail price per bag above which rice of that description and grade shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of column I. of that Schedule,
 (ii.) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per bag above which rice of that description and grade shall not be sold within the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column I. of that Schedule,
 (ii.) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per measure that the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per measure.
- within the Colombo Municipal area above which rice of any description and grade shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column III. of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price per measure above which rice of that description and grade shall not be sold in the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column I. of the Second Schedule,
- (iii.) direct that every trader who exposes for sale rice of any description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto at premises within the limits of any area mentioned in column I of the Second Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order for rice of that

description and grade : (iv.) direct that no trader shall sell rice of any description and grade mentioned in column I of the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article or with rice of any inferior description and grade or quality; prescribe that every trader who sells rice of any description and grade mentioned in column I. of the First Schedule hereto

shall give to the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out-

- (a) the description and grade of rice sold;

- (a) the description and grade of first solar,
 (b) the quantity of rice sold;
 (c) the price paul for the quantity of rice sold;
 (d) the date of the sale, and
 (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was wholesale or retail, as the case may be.

(vi.) direct that for the purpose of this Order-

(a) a bag of rice other than Broken Raw Rice shall contain not less than 77 measures and 154 pounds of rice by

- (a) a bag of rice other than Broken Baw Rice shall contain not less than 77 measures and 134 pounds of rice weight;
 (b) a bag of Broken Baw Rice shall contain not less than 115 measures and 239 pounds of rice by weight;
 (c) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be sale by retail;
 (d) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 (e) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure, equivalent to one thirty second part of a bushel;
 (f) the maximum price which may be demanded within any area mentioned in column I. of the Second Schedule hereto for a quantity of rice which is less than a bag but not less than one bushel shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag prescribed by this Order in respect of that area for rice of that description and grade;
 (g) the maximum prices fixed by this Order for rice of any description and grade which is sold, either by wholesale or by retail, in a quantity of one bushel or more shall include the container in which such rice is sold;
- (vii.) direct that the provisions of this Order shall apply to the descriptions and grade of rice mentioned in the First Schedule herete

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, John Radley Walters, Deputy Controller of Prices, Badulla District, do, by this Order ----

- (i.) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum wholesale price per bag at the Granaries, Colombo, above which rice of any description and grade shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column II of the Second Schedule hereto, as the maximum retail price per bag above which rice of that description and grade shall not be sold within the area mentioned in the corresponding entry miceling 1 to that Schedule
- (u) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per measure within the Colombo Municipal area above which rice of any description and grade shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column III. of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price per measure above which rice of that description and grade shall not be sold in the area mentioned in the "corresponding entry in column I of the Second Schedule."
- (iii) direct that every trader who exposes for sale rice of any description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto at premises within the limits of any area mentioned in column I. of the Second Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous, position at those premises a notice in which shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order for rice of that description and grade
- (iv) direct that no trader shall sell rice of any description and grade mentioned in column I. of the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article or with rice of any inferior description and grade or quality;
 (v.) prescribe that every trader who sells rice of any description and grade mentioned in column I of the First Schedule hereto

shall give to the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out-

- (a) the description and grade of rice sold ;
- the quantity of rice sold ;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; (d) the date of the sale, and

(e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was wholesale or retail as the case may be;

(vi.) direct that for the purpose of this Order :--

(a) a bag of any rice other than Broken Raw Rice shall contain not less than 77 measures and 154 pounds of rice by weight :

weight;
(b) a bag of Broken Raw Rice shall contain not less than 115 measures and 239 pounds of rice by weight;
(c) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be sale by retail;
(d) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
(e) "measure "shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure, equivalent to one thirty-second part of a bushel;
(f) the maximum price which may be demanded within any area mentioned in column I. of the Second Schedule hereto for a quantity of rice per bag prescribed by this Order in respect of that area for rice of that description and grade;
(g) the maximum prices fixed by this Order for rice of any description and grade which is sold, either by wholesale or retail, in a quantity of one bushel of rice is sold;

(vii) direct that the provisions of this Order shall apply to the descriptions and grades of rice mentioned in the First Schedule hereto


