MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

The Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Town Hall on Saturday, May 25, 1895, at 8.30 o'clock a.m.

Present:—Hqn. Allanson Bailey, Chairman; Dr. Frederick Keyt; R. D. Ormsby, Esq.; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; B. de Alwis, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on April 27 were read and confirmed.

2. The following documents were laid on the table:—Statement of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from close of 1894 to April 30 last; also separate statements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water-rate Accounts; Progress Report of Work done brought up to the same date; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of April; also Health Officer's report.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Municipal-Councils' Ordinance, be forwarded, with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary, together with the Health Officer's report.

3. The Chairman submitted Supplemental Budget No. 1, which had obtained the approval of the Standing Committee, and a copy of which had been furnished to each Member as required by section 113.

It was unanimously resolved that the Supplemental Budget No. 1 be sanctioned as follows:—

4. The Chairman submitted his annual Administration Report for 1894.

Resolved,—That the report be forwarded to Government, and a request made that the Council be furnished with twenty printed copies, and that the consideration of the report, as required by section 115 of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance, be deferred, as hitherto, until after receipt of the printed copies.

5. Read letter dated May 16, from Mr. M. Cochran, City Analyst, forwarding an analysis of a sample of water drawn off from a standpost in the town, and sent down on May 10.

Resolved, on motion of the Chairman,—That notices in three languages, similar to one recently issued by the Principal Civil Medical Officer, be issued to residents within the Municipality, recommending that the water used for drinking purposes be first boiled, allowed to cool, and then, if possible, filtered.

6. Read Memorandum dated May 13, from the Colonial Secretary, forwarding copy of letter No. 411, dated May 13, to the Director of Public Works, in respect of the works suggested in Chairman's letter No. 6 of November 19, 1894, and proposed to be charged to the unappropriated balance of Rs. 2,500 voted in the Supply Bill for 1894 "For repairs to and renewal of drains in Trincomalee street."

Resolved,—That the Colonial Secretary be again addressed on the subject, and informed that the drains in question are used less for sewerage purposes than the drain in Trincomalee street, in fact some not at all, but that if Government will sanction the expenditure of the unappropriated balance on the improvement of the drains referred to, the Municipal Council will be prepared to vote an equivalent amount for the same purpose.

It has been found necessary to cut off the water supply during the middle of the day, as the reservoir was getting low, but no ill effects have followed.

The cattle shed, slaughter-house, public latrines, and market have been kept in a good sanitary condition.

By-laws referred to.

- 1. Water shall not be drawn from the public standpipes otherwise than into a vessel or receptacle.
- 2. The public standpipes shall not be used for the purposes of bathing or washing of persons or animals or clothes, or any other thing.
- 3. No contrivance of any kind whatever shall be used for fixing the handles of the standpipes in order to secure a continuous flow of water.
