MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held at the Municipal Office on June 22, 1895, at 3 p.m.

Present :—The Chairman; Dr. P. D. Anthonisz, c.m.g.; Dr. J. Attygalle; C. P. Hayley, Esq.; C. L. M. Abdul Carim, Esq.; W. Abeyasundera, Esq.; and D. G. Goonewardena, Esq.

1. Read Minutes of Meeting held on May 21 last, pursuant to notice dated June 17, 1895.

Mr. Hayley stated that he was informed that sufficient notice had not been given of this Meeting, and objected to the confirmation of the Minutes.

The Chairman replied, that as the notice of Meeting was dated the 17th (and was sent to the Members on that day), and that the Meeting was not held till May 21, the requirements of the 89th section of the Municipal Councils' Ordinance have been complied with.

Resolved,—That the Minutes be confirmed.

2. The notice of motions given by Dr. Anthonisz on the 18th instant to be brought forward this day being found not to have been given three clear days before the Meeting, he desired to withdraw them.

3. Read letter No. 286 from Government to the Government Agent, Southern Province, dated June 13, 1895 on the outbreak of malarious fever, forwarded by that official for the information of Council.

Read also a letter from the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, dated June 21, 1895, No. 17, forwarding a report from the Chief Resident Engineer, Railway Extension, on the same subject.

Resolved,—That an additional sum of Rs. 250 be allowed for the relief of distress amongst the destitute sick.

4. Submitted Chairman's Administration Report for 1894.

Resolved,—That it be circulated among the Members of the Council.

5. Submitted the following recommendation from the Standing Committee at a Meeting held on June 22, 1895:—"That the regulations framed under section 9 of the Rabies Ordinance, No. 7 of 1893, transmitted with the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 15 of June 17, 1895, be approved, and that it be recommended to the Council for adoption."

Resolved,—That the regulations referred to be adopted.

6. Submitted accounts for the month of May, 1895.
 7. Submitted Superintendent's reports for 1895.
 8. The Chairman mentioned that by a misunderstanding the reservoir at Bikke had been altogether emptied instead of as decided at last Meeting. The feeling of the Council was that this was on the whole advantageous.

(g) Renewed Pittigalla cross drain ; building the Pittigalla-ela with stone and mortar ; and repaired China Garden road side drains ; and forming a road on side of Pittigalla-ela.

(h) Repaired garden seats ; built lines for coolies ; clearing sewers ; prepared materials for a fence round the Pavilion ; building an office room for the Superintendent.

(i) Cost of repairs of windmill and pay of cooly in charge.

(k) Built a sea latrine at Kaluwella.

(l) Opened a lane at Havelock place ; paid for 7,000 bricks for road on southern boundary of China Garden ; forming a road to join the Matara road at Pittigallawattu with the Talapitiya road.

(m) Improved Fort market.
