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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, August 9, 1895.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated August 3, 1895.

*Present*:—Mr. F. H. Price, Acting Chairman and Mayor of Colombo; Captain F. Bayley; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Mr. E. Creasy; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of July 12 and 30, 1895, having been printed and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of July 12 and 30, 1895, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne moved "that steps be taken to acquire land for the purpose of widening and improving Wall's lane opposite the Blomendal mills."

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

2. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to July 31, 1895, and a Progress Report of Work done during July, 1895, were laid on the table.

3. The following recommendations made by the Standing Committee on August 2, 1895, were laid before the Council :—

4. Estimate for gullies, St. John's road, Rs. 190.

Resolved that the estimate of Rs. 190 be passed; and that the transfer of this amount for the purpose from vote 27 in the Supplemental Budget be recommended to the Council.

7. Estimate for a drain at Maligakanda road, Rs. 45.

Resolved that the estimate of Rs. 45 be passed, and that the transfer of this amount for the purpose from vote 27 in the Supplemental Budget be recommended to the Council.

Resolved,—That the foregoing recommendations of the Standing Committee be adopted.

4. The report of the Special Committee on the proposed conversion of the Kachcheri grass garden into a recreation ground was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Resolved,—That the report be adopted.

5. A further letter No. 105 of July 27, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the duplication of the water main, was laid before the Council, with connected papers, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Alvis moved "that this Council regrets that it cannot see its way to depart from the terms of the resolution of July 12 last. Though a number of the Members were of opinion that the work of duplicating the water main rested entirely with the Government, yet, in order to expedite such duplication, the Council agreed to contribute Rs. 600,000 on the conditions in said resolution embodied. This Council feels that this is the utmost it could reasonably be expected to do in the circumstances."

Captain Bayley seconded.

Whereupon the motion was carried.

6. A letter No. 79 of June 21, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, relating to the extension of the Municipal limits, was laid before the Council, with connected papers.

Mr. Morgan moved "that the Council are not prepared to accept the proposal now made by Government, and would respectfully request the Government to re-consider the original proposal embodied in their resolution of December 14, 1894, forwarded to the Colonial Secretary with letter No. 273 of December 18, 1894."

Mr. Haniffa seconded.—Carried.

7. An application dated April 4, 1895, from Mr. E. LaBrooy, Superintendent of the Bridge-of-boats, asking for further employment in the service of the Council after the closing of the bridge was laid before the Council.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne moved the adoption of the resolution No. 16 17 of the Standing Committee of August 2, 1895, and that Mr. LaBrooy's pay be fixed at Rs. 100 per mensem.

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

8. A letter No. 103 of July 23, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, on the question of lighting the Victoria Bridge and the approach road with electricity, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That resolution No. 5 of the Standing Committee of August 5, 1895, be adopted.

9. A letter No. 98 of July 11, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to Military reserves, was read.

10. A letter No. 95 of July 9, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, suggesting for consideration a proposal to form a street along the approach road to the Victoria Bridge, was laid before the Council.

Mr. Morgan moved "that the matter be referred to a Committee consisting of the Chairman, Hon. R. K. MacBride, Captain Bayley, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne, and Mr. C. Perera—three Members to form a quorum."

Mr. Dias seconded.—Carried.

11. Further remarks by the Auditor-General on the accounts for March and September, 1893, and May and November, 1894, were laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the remarks be referred to the Standing Committee.

12. Resolved that the number of opium licenses to be issued for 1896, under section 3 of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1889, be four.

13. The City Analyst's report dated July 18, 1895, on the town water for July, 1895, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

14. The Sanitary Officer's report for second quarter, 1895, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

Resolved,—That the report be referred to the Standing Committee.

15. An application dated July 24, 1895, for a gratuity from W. P. Fernando, a retired Collector and Division Officer, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the Council is unable to grant a gratuity.

16. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for August, 1895, were laid on the table.
