LOCAL BOARD NOTICES.

NOTICE is hereby given to persons residing within the limits of the Local Board of Matara, that the Board, acting under the provisions of section 3 of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1887, has imposed an annual tax payable in six days' labour upon all persons residing within the limits of the Board, who would have been liable, under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, to the performance of labour for the maintenance of roads or other public means of communication by land or by water, if the Ordinance No. 7 of 1876 had not been passed.
