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## MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

#### Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, October 11, 1895.

The Council met this day at 3 P. M., pursuant to notice dated October 5, 1895.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Acting Mayor and Chairman; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Mr. E. Creasy; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of September 13, 1895, having been printed and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved.—That the Minutes of September 13, 1895, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna asked “if the attention of the Government has been called to the absence of police protection at the Victoria Bridge and its approach road, and moved for papers.”

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.

The Acting Inspector-General of Police explained that the Government having sanctioned the employment of extra men, two constables were now placed in charge of the Victoria Bridge.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. Alvis moved “that this Council do present His Excellency the Governor with a valedictory address on his departure from the Island, and that a Committee be appointed to draft such address.”

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

Resolved,—That the Special Committee do consist of the Chairman, Sir John J. Grinlinton; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna, Mr. C. M. Fernando, and Mr. A. Alvis—three Members to form a quorum.

3. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to September 30, 1895, and a Progress Report of Work done during September, 1895, were laid on the table.

4. The following recommendation from the Standing Committee of September 6, 1895, was laid before the Council :—

(18) Application to lease the triangular bit of ground at the junction of Layard's Broadway and Grand-pass road.

Resolved,—That tenders be invited.

Resolved,—That the recommendation of the Standing Committee be approved, and that Government be requested to sanction the lease of the land referred to.

5. A report dated October 4, 1895, of the Special Committee on the Chairman's Administration Report for 1894 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved the adoption of the report.

Mr. Haniffa seconded.—Carried.

6. A letter No. 138 of September 24, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the bathing-place in the lake opposite the Echelon barracks, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved “that the Sanitary Officer having reported that the promontory to the east of Parson's road is suitable for a bathing-place, the Council do set it apart for the purpose in substitution for the place now used near the Echelon barracks; further, that a Committee consisting of the Chairman, Mr. Finlay, Dr. Vanderstraaten, Mr. Creasy, Mr. Chas. Perera, Mr. C. M. Fernando, and Mr. A. Alvis be appointed to consider the general question of bathing-places in the lake—three Members to form a quorum.”

Mr. Alvis seconded.—Carried.

7. A letter No. 142 of September 30, 1895, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to the Registration of Deaths Ordinance, 1891, and the increased death-rate of the town of Colombo, was laid before the Council, with a memorandum by the Chairman on the subject, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved “that the papers be referred to the Special Committee already appointed on September 13, 1895, to consider and report upon the gradual improvement of the sanitary condition of the overcrowded localities of the town.”

Mr. Morgan seconded.—Carried.

8. A notification dated October 7, 1895, from the Chairman, was read, to the effect that Sir John J. Grinlinton having been absent from three consecutive General Meetings had vacated his seat as a Member of the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved “that Sir John J. Grinlinton be restored to office, in accordance with clause 32 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887.”

Mr. Alvis seconded.—Carried.

9. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for April, 1895, received with letter No. 63 of September 21, 1895, were laid on the table.

10. The City Analyst's report dated October 4, 1895, on the town water for September, 1895, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

11. A memorandum recommending the destruction of certain old documents relating to the slaughter-houses was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That authority be granted to destroy the records specified in the memorandum.

12. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for October, 1895, were laid on the table.

13. An application dated September 16, 1895, from Mr. J. S. Driberg, for the purchase of the disused quarry in Elie lane was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the consent of the Governor be obtained, in the first instance, in the sale of the quarry in question, in terms of section 72 of Ordinance 7 of 1887.
